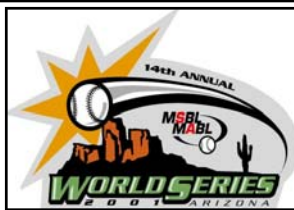

MSBL AGE CHANGES BECOME OFFICIAL IN 2002 (28+ / 38+ / 48+)

Starting with the 2002 MSBL season, the official age of eligible MSBL players will be lowered in all divisions. This includes the 30+, 40+, 50+ and 60+ World Series divisions. National MSBL / MABL President, Steve Sigler made the official announcement during the managers meeting on Saturday night.

SCOREBOOK.COM PROVIDING REAL TIME STATS FOR 2001 WS

New this year to the MSBL / MABL WS Tournament is the addition of the on line statistics firm, ScoreBook.com. As the official Sports League Management site for the MSBL/MABL this year, they kept track of all participating teams stats in the leagues that subscribed to their program. This service was so popular that MSBL President, Steve Sigler invited them to provide the teams participating in this years World Series with the same type of coverage, at no cost. Located in the MSBL World Series Information Office (*the Novelty Shop at Tempe Diablo Stadium on the mezzanine level behind first base*) they have three main frame computers set up to track stat leaders in several different offensive categories. To accomplish this enormous task, the ScoreBook.com staff has provided each team manager with ten separate work sheets (one for each game) for both the batting lineup and pitching totals. After each game both teams should fill out the forms and return them to the World Series office, located at Tempe Diablo Stadium.

The 2001 MSBL / MABL World Series Tournament began yesterday with teams in the 30+ National and American Divisions. The new format this year allows the 30+ National and American teams the opportunity to play more stadium games than ever before. Nine National teams and seven American will play six games each in pool play, before starting the playoff round on Thursday. By moving to the first week, these teams have benefited by playing on better fields with less night games. The MABL portion of the tournament gets underway on Wednesday. In week two, the rest of the thirty plus division teams start play, Continental, Federal and Central. Those teams will be joined by the Father & Son teams (which start on Thursday October 25th). The final week of the tournament will conclude with the 40+, 50+ and 60+ Divisions. In all, over 1000 pool play games will be played, 120 playoff games and 19 championship winners will be crowned by the MSBL.
