#### MABL WORLD SERIES SET TO START TODAY WITH 46 TEAMS

The MABL World Series opens today with games in three separate divisions. National, American and Central teams will all play five (5) games in the next three days to determine which teams will advance to the playoffs. Four of five teams in National Division will qualify for the playoffs. Twelve of twenty three American Division teams will advance and eight of eighteen Central Division teams will move on to the playoff round. Pool play ends on Friday as the first round of the playoffs start on Saturday. The MABL championship games will be played on Sunday. Several teams face must win situations today. With only a few playoff spots still open the teams that haven't already clinched need a win today. The first tie breaker is head to head competition, while the next tie breaker is the all important runs allowed category. If two have identical records and haven't played each other, the team allowing the least amount of runs during the pool play games would be seeded ahead of the other team. The top two teams in each division earn a bye and will play the winner of a first round playoff contest.

First round 30+ National and American playoffs will be played at Fitch Park fields 1-2-3 and Hohokam Aux on Thursday morning. Second round games will start at 2:00p. Both of the Championship games are scheduled to be played on Friday. An exception to this will be made in the National Division if the Long Island Storm advance to the finals. Due to the flight time constraints of several players, the championship game will be played on Thursday evening. National Division managers agreed to this at the manager meeting.






