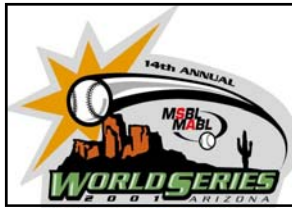

2001 MSBL WORLD SERIES SEPERATES 30+ DIVISION FOR THE FIRST TIME — NATIONAL AND AMERICAM TEAMS PLAYED THE FIRST WEEK

The thirty plus division of the World Series was separated for the first time in the history of tournament this past week. The 30+ National and American Division teams started the tournament last Sunday, October 14th. Pool play games were played Sunday through Wednesday, the playoffs were held on Thursday and the championship games were set for Friday. Midway through the week, the MABL World Series began in which 46 teams participated. This week, the 30+ Continental, Federal and Central teams will play their pool games Monday through Thursday, playoffs will be held on Friday and the championship games will be played on Saturday. The Father and Son World Series will be played on Thursday and Friday, with the playoffs on Saturday and the Championship games on Sunday. To this point the weather has been perfect, not a cloud in the sky and the temperatures have been ideal. The Trade Show will be held next weekend, starting Friday.

EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED - SO WHAT IF THIS HAPPENS?

Problem: You team shows up for a game and you don't see any umpires at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the game?

Solution: Call the WS office hotline, 602-438-0242. We have a standby ump on call and will send him out to your game.

Problem: You want to lodge an official protest and you're not sure how to do that.. (The clock for the game does not stop during this period)

Solution: Immediately inform the home plate umpire of the protest and he will call the WS office and get an official ruling.

Problem: You determine that the other team has a player that is batting out of turn. You decide to protest this infraction (after the game ends) and hope that the out come of the game will be reversed.

Solution: Any player caught batting out of turn before the next pitch is thrown will be ruled upon by the umpires on the field. If discovered after the next pitch or play, his turn at bat becomes legal.

Problem: The standings reflect a different number of runs allowed than your team has actually had scored against them. How do you correct it?

Solution: Call the WS office and go over your game scores, game by game.

Problem: Your team is not sure if you've made the playoffs and the players will be out on the town that night and won't get in til late.

Solution: Make sure the WS staff can reach you or someone by 8:00pm.

MSBL WS HOME RUN HITTING CONTEST TO BE HELD FRIDAY NIGHT AT STADIUM

This year the Home Run Derby will be held on Friday night at Tempe Diablo Stadium. Every player who wants to will have the opportunity to see who can hit the most home runs and lay claim to the bragging rights of MSBL "Home Run" champ for the 2001 World Series.

The entry fee will be \$25 (per player) and the first place prize will include their picture in HardBall magazine, a Black Magic Easton bat (33 inch - 28 oz) model and \$250. The runner up will receive his choice of the prizes on display. The top 5 HR run contestants will win a prize.

Home run contest rules are as follows: All players must provide their own bat and pitcher. During the first round each player gets ten (10) swings. Only balls that clear the fence and are fair balls, will be counted. After the first round, the players who have hit the most HR's will repeat the process in round two. The contest will continue until one player has hit more HR's than anyone else.

The contest will begin at 7:00p at Tempe Diablo stadium and only cash will be accepted, no checks.

Players may enter the contest anytime between now and Friday night. The order of hitting will be determined by when a player signs up.
