FATHER & SON WORLD SERIES GETS UNDERWAY TODAY

The 2001 Father & Son World Series begins today with each of the teams playing a double header. Twenty one teams will compete in two divisions, National and American. During the F/S manager meeting last night, Val Lewis (Father & Son Commissioner) outlined the revamped rules that this special format requires. First and foremost, this is a wood bat tournament. Additionally the F/S tournament has adopted some new guidelines to help expand the growth of this division. In years past, daughters have been allowed to join their fathers, so have son-in-laws, uncle's and step sons. The basic premise of the team concept hasn't changed. Defensively at least four fathers must be on the field and five in the batting order at all times. According to Val Lewis, the main goal of this tournament is not winning, but participation. The new guidelines have been put in place to allow forty year old fathers the opportunity to compete on a more level playing field. College players and high school varsity athletes can be on a teams roster, but their father must play at least three (3) innings and get a minimum of one (1) at bat. The MSBL World Series is a premier show case event and the Father and Son Division should continue to expand each year.

TIME RUNNING OUT FOR TEAMS HOPING TO QUALIFY FOR A PLAYOFF SPOT — EXPANDED WILDCARD SPOTS WILL HELP SOME TEAMS GET IN

On Wednesday afternoon, the World Series staff decided to increase the number of teams that would qualify for the Continental playoffs. The decision to expand the Federal and Central playoffs had already been announced and this was consistent in keeping with trying to reward as many teams as possible with a playoff game. Second and just as important in expanding the Continental playoffs was that it was possible for a Continental team to qualify for the playoffs, get two bye's and play only one game to reach the championship. The Continental Division originally had seventeen teams, two divisions made up of eight and nine teams. Before the 30+ World Series began one of those teams dropped and created an imbalance in the schedule with a seven and nine team division.

The new playoff bracket for the Continental Division can be found on page five. The first and second place teams will receive a bye into the second round, while the third and fourth place teams will play the top four wild cards from the division. Continental playoff games on Friday will be seven innings. The game times for round one will begin at 9:30a, round two gets under way at 1:15p and the semi-final games will be played at 5:00p.

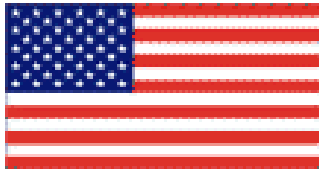

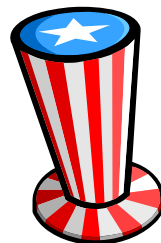

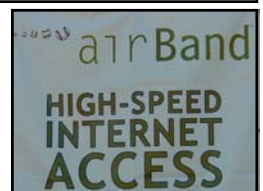
