

OKC BRAVES WIN 30+ WS AS A WILDCARD TEAM!



The 30+ Continental Oklahoma Braves after winning the 2001 MSBL World Series Championship at Papago Park yesterday. The OKC Braves beat the LA Grays 6 - 4.

WILDCARD OKLAHOMA CITY BRAVES CAPTURE MSBL WORLD SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP TITLE AFTER GOING 2 - 4 IN POOL PLAY ROUND By Tom Prendergast

The 30+ Continental Oklahoma City Braves finished the tournament as the last team left standing, capping an amazing comeback after a lack luster performance in the pool play round. The Braves split their first two games on Monday, lost their game Tuesday, split on Wednesday and lost their game on Thursday to finish 2-4, with 64 runs allowed. On Wednesday, the World Series office added two additional playoff berths, increasing the teams that qualify from 14 to 16. Without that change, the Braves would have missed out on the playoffs altogether, because based on their runs allowed they were the 15th seed in the division. After qualifying the Oklahoma City Braves were a different team. They won three, seven inning games on Friday, defeating the Fresno Tribe 10 - 6, the New Jersey Knights (the division winner) 6 - 2, and the West LA Indians 10 - 3. In the pool play round the Braves allowed an average of 10.6 runs per game but in the playoffs cut that down to 3.6 runs per game. Playing better defense with more consistent pitching allowed them to beat teams that finished ahead of them in the division and become the first wildcard team to capture an MSBL World Series championship in fourteen years.





EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED - SO WHAT IF THIS HAPPENS?

Problem: You team shows up for a game and you don't see any umpires at

least 15 minutes prior to the start of the game?

Solution: Call the WS office hotline, 602-438-0242. We have a standby ump

on call and will send him out to your game.

Problem: You want to lodge an official protest and you're not sure how to do

that.. (The clock for the game does not stop during this period)

Solution: Immediately inform the home plate umpire of the protest and he

will call the WS office and get an official ruling.

Problem: You determine that the other team has a player that is batting out of

turn. You decide to protest this infraction (after the game ends) and

hope that the out come of the game will be reversed.

Solution: Any player caught batting out of turn before the next pitch is

thrown will be ruled upon by the umpires on the field. If discovered after the next pitch or play, his turn at bat becomes legal.

Problem: The standings reflect a different number of runs allowed than your

team has actually had scored against them. How do you correct it? **Solution:** Call the WS office and go over your game scores, game by game.

Problem: Your team is not sure if you've made the playoffs and the players

will be out on the town that night and won't get in til late.

Solution: Make sure the WS staff can reach you or someone by 8:00pm.



MSBL WS HOME RUN HITTING CONTEST TO BE HELD FRIDAY NIGHT AT STADIUM

This year the Home Run Derby will be held on Friday night at Tempe Diablo Stadium. Every player who wants to will have the opportunity to see who can hit the most home runs and lay claim to the bragging rights of MSBL "Home Run" champ for the 2001 World Series.


The contest will begin at 7:00p at Tempe Diablo stadium and only cash will be accepted, no checks.


