40+ / 50+ / 60+ MSBL WS GETS UNDERWAY WITH 150 TEAMS

The final week of the 2001 MSBL World Series began yesterday with the 40+, 50+ and 60+ divisions. Week # 3, by far the largest of the tournament with 150 teams and 100-plus games per day. In the pool play round alone (Monday through Thursday) 450 games will be played with the playoffs starting on Friday and the championship games (9 separate divisions) all day Saturday.

DRAMA FILLED CHAMPIONSHIP GAMES PROVIDE EXCITING AND UNEXPECTED RESULTS IN THE FIRST TWO WEEKS OF THE WORLD SERIES

Down three runs with one out in the bottom of the ninth, the Father and Son Sacramento Cardinal team still felt like they had a chance to win the game. They had already come back from a seven run deficit and at one point held a one run lead. The Cardinals scored four runs to capture an exciting 13-12 championship victory and win the F/S American Division championship. Just as exciting was the 1-0 pitcher's duel win in which the Tri Valley Tigers defeated the Sacramento Senators for the F/S National championship. The day before, the 30+ Continental Oklahoma City Braves became the first wild card team to win a World Series championship after going 2-4 in pool play. A week earlier the Dallas Hansen Energy 30+ National team won the championship game in the bottom of the 9th.

**Diary of an Aging Baseball Player**

One Jugs Curveball Pitching Machine \$1,695.
One Portolite 2-piece Pitching Mound with simulated rubber cover--\$799
One Instructo-Swing--\$175 (On Sale).
One base hit off a slider--Priceless.

The Men's Senior Baseball Trade Show offered the first three items. Neither the Trade Show or MasterCard have figured out number four.

The closest I came was a short listen to Mike Epstein talking about hitting. Shoot, I can *talk* about hitting.

But, I digress. I truly look forward to the Trade Show each year. It gives me the opportunity to shop for hard-to-find baseball items. It also gives me new material for a Daily News column. The purpose of this column is to provide a review of the products offered at this year's show. And, the lineup included the usual, as well as some unusual suspects.

One product category you can always count on--the T-shirt. It looked like the vendors were selling a few. But, can you show me one MSBL player who *needs* another T-shirt? I have a shelf full of just MSBL shirts. They share closet space with the NHL, NBA, and NFL shirts. I also have collected an "Official Indy 500 Photographer" shirt even though I've never attended the Inday 500, let alone photograph it. My closet also sports a carryover from my Mizzou Grad School days, "Tuck Fexas."

The September 11th inspired patriotism has inspired several new lines of T-shirts. I particularly enjoyed the Baseball Wife series that included such inspirational messages as "Baseball Widow." That line also includes the junior version "Baseball Orphan." I thought about buying one for my wife but reconsidered. She doesn't really think of herself as a baseball widow. She *prefers* I spend my weekday nights at the Mid-America Sports Complex as opposed to Bazooka's, The Shady Lady, or The Platinum Club. Betsy is one clear-thinking woman.

The Trade Show gives us the opportunity to see all of the latest "required" equipment. I refer to gloves, batting helmets, undershirt, pants, and sliding shorts.

Check that. I'm beginning to wonder if I really need sliding shorts. I have long followed the rule of "only slide when you're the tying run, winning run, or playing on a field in Phoenix." I might slide more often at our home ballpark, but I would rather slide on an exit ramp on I-35 than near our second base. If NASA needs an indestructible substance to replace the tiles on the Space Shuttle, they should dig up the surface of 2nd base at Mid-America. (*The Mid America Sports Complex is home to the KC MSBL*)

The Trade Show trek also reminded me of several of my baseball pet peeves. Peeve #1--batting gloves. Stan Musial had 3,672 hits without ever using batting gloves. Mickey Mantle hit 536 home runs without ever using batting gloves. My numbers may be off, but you get the point. My son offers a frank assessment of the value of the batting glove, "My hands don't sting."

I counter, "If you don't hit it on the button, your hands should sting." I'm obviously losing that argument. I counted at least 37 different models of batting gloves on display. Perhaps if they displayed 38 I would have changed my mind. Don't count on it.

Peeve #2--batting sleeves. These foam rubber cylinders serve as monuments to solutions in search of problems. Similarly constructed "Koozies" keep your favorite canned beverage cool. Is that the objective of the batting sleeve? Even the extremely superstitious Cerrano (remember Hats for Bats?) in the movie *Major League* never resorted to cooling his bats. Wait a minute. I get it. The wraps keep your bats from clanging against each other in your bat bag. But, who carries two aluminum bats? Maybe that's why I prefer wood bats. You want your bat to look used. The more pine tar, the more nicks and scrapes, the better your bat looks. And, when your bat "looks" good it hits good.

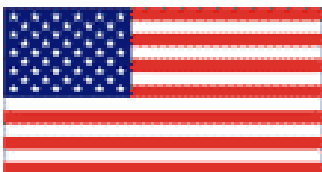

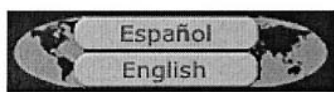
