

### WORLD SERIES STAFF REVIEWS 60+ DIVISION ADDS A 60+ AMERICAN PLAYOFF ROUND THIS YEAR— 2 SEMIFINALS PLAY FOR DIVISION TITLE

After further review, the World Series staff has decided to get a jump on next year and include a 60+ American Division playoffs for this years tournament. Two semi final games will be played on Friday (2:00p at Papago Park) and the Division title game will be held on Saturday afternoon at Tempe #2. This change will allow four additional 60+ teams to qualify for the playoff round on Friday.

MSBL National President, Steve Sigler announced at the managers meeting on Sunday night that starting with the 2002 World Series, the 60+ Division teams would be split in two, National and American. While not an official championship game, each of the winners will receive a v neck pullover World Series style jacket. The time and place of the American title game will be announced later.

#### Diary of an Aging Baseball Player

My good friend Bill Harmon and I have two different ideas about how to prepare for the annual Phoenix World Series. But, that's not particularly surprising because we have two different ideas about how to prepare for the rest of our lives.

Bill subscribes to what I would call the "Limited Time Theory." Those who live under the LTT believe the Good Lord has granted them a certain number of hours to play baseball. Therefore, one must try to cram as many innings, AB's, or pitches into a week, month, or year as possible.

That means the week leading up to the MSBL World Series looks something like this:

Monday--batting practice, weightlifting

Tuesday--batting practice, infield practice

Wednesday--batting practice, pitching practice, weightlifting

Thursday--batting practice, outfield practice Friday--batting practice, weightlifting, movie

Saturday--batting practice, infield practice, outfield practice, pitching practice Sunday--fly to Phoenix, batting practice

On the other hand, I subscribe to the "Limited Innings Theory." Those who live under the LIT believe the Good Lord has granted them only a certain number of innings, and the objective is to spread those innings over the maximum number of years.

That means my week leading up to the MSBL World Series looks something like this: Monday--check e-mail, wash baseball undershirts, watch Monday Night Football Tuesday--check e-mail, check voice mail, wash baseball socks, watch rerun of The Sopranos starring Jamie-Lynn Sigler

Wednesday--check e-mail, wash baseball pants, read latest issue of Rolling Stone Thursday--check e-mail, check voice mail, review MSBL Website, watch NHL game on ESPN

Friday--go to two movies

Saturday--rest

Sunday--fly to Phoenix, batting practice, attend Trade Show, check e-mail

Bill has also developed a corollary to that theory. The corollary includes provisions for softball innings, basketball games, and I suppose--jousts. In a typical calendar year, Bill Harmon will play 90-100 baseball games, 120-plus softball games, and 30 or 40 basketball games. I don't think he's ever been in a joust, but that's only because the Men's Senior Jousting hasn't made it to North America. Do the math on those games and it comes to more than 365. A typical weekend might hold six softball games, an MSBL doubleheader and a couple of over-50 basketball games.

Bill likes to point to the validity of his theory by reminding me of his brush with death a few years ago. He suffered a heart attack and collapsed while playing a basketball game. Only the alert actions of two bystanders who knew CPR saved his life. I came to visit him in the hospital. There he was, a dozen tubes going into every geographic region of his body, and he was telling me he'd be back on the field in "a couple of weeks."

"Don't you need a couple of months?" I asked

"Naw, I've only got a certain number of days left. I've gotta get back playin'."


Bill Harmon was back on the field in two weeks.

Now it's hard to criticize Bill. Even at 50-something, he's one of the best players in the Kansas City MSBL. I just want him to hang around long enough to play in the over-60 division.

I must go now. Bill and I just played two games where a total of 48 runs crossed the plate.

I'm hungry so I'm headed to Stuart Anderson's Steak House. You can probably find Bill at the batting cages at Hayden and McKellips.

Until Mr. Sigler founded MSBL I thought those innings would be amortized

# Pitching Pigeons By Clyde E. Miller

By now everyone has seen the vid-

eo of Randy Johnson pitching and flat out nailing a pigeon with a fastball. Feathers fly, the crowd gasps, the catcher looks startled and Randy starts arguing with the umpire about the call. I've been inspired to start a cottage industry because of this one particular incident. I call the business "PITCHNG PIGEONS INC." You probably guessed it. I raise pigeons for pitching practice. Since we hear so much in the MSBL about a moving strike zone, what better way to train pitchers than to give them a moving target to pitch too. I checked the numbers, pigeons, at their fastest travel about 65 mph. Pitchers in the MSBL at their best average about 70 mph. So here is the formula to figure P=Pigeon velocity divided by P2=Pitcher velocity X M1=height of the pitching mound with an exponent of the temperature=56% of the gross national income minus the beer consumption of the 40+ Central Division champions and you get a rough estimate of how to hit a pigeon on the fly with a wild pitch. It is going to take a lot of pigeons to

practice; we're looking at 1725 pigeons at roughly \$45 a dozen on any given day. Multiple that by a reasonable 65 practices 112,125 Times \$45 and you can do the numbers. Now Rawlings (the official MSBL pigeon sponsor) sells pigeons for just over \$54 a dozen. These are the raised feather pigeons, not the low seamed feather pigeons you get from China or some such place. Better flight time, better velocity and when hit with a pitched ball they explode! I bought a dozen of their pigeons and have been breeding my own. Same feathers, same performance, different logo. I can also dye the feathers a team color. You want red pigeons, I've got them. Wow, you say I could do that. Sure you could, but you didn't and you won't. Pigeons are messy, loud, and stupid. The bird feed alone takes up the garage. I have also trained these particular pitching pigeons to be "homer" pigeons. When pitching at them and you miss...they fly home. Once there I can resell them again as a new product since they are not yet in the Hit By Pitch Statistics. There is also the SPCA (Stupid People Causing Accidents) to deal with. They will whine about the unnecessary deaths of birds, the carnage, the pain, yada, yada, yada...I just hit them with a 30 ounce, 32 inch, light colored wide grained, handle number 4 and they leave me alone. Finally, if you have never had tenderized pigeon you should cry "FOWL"! Give me a call when you need a Pitching Pigeon. (also good for weddings, peace conferences, practical jokes and magic tricks)
