2003 MABL World Series Starts Today With 57 Teams In Four Divisions

The second wave of players arrive today for the start of the MABL World Series. Eight National division teams, 12 American, 23 Federal, and 14 Central division teams will begin play today. Each MABL team will play 5 games in pool play before the playoffs start on Saturday.

While the MABL games are just beginning the 28+ division games are wrapping up. In the very competitive National division, the Tri Valley Cubs and the Atlanta Astros are both 4-1 and tied for 1st, the Scottsdale Mudcats are in third at 3-2 while the Sacramento Giants and the Dallas Brewers are 1-3. In the 28+ American division the Sacramento Angels are the only undefeated team left at 5-0, the Pacific Coast Breakers are in second place at 4-1, followed by Scottsdale Finest 3-1-1, and Wilson/DiMarini Giants 2-1-2, in fourth place.

In 28+ Continental division 1, the Tri Valley/Cytosport Indians and the Columbus A's are both 4-1 while the Tucson A's have a record of 3-2 and are in third place. The Smokey Pointe Giants and the LA Westside Dawgs are both 2-3. Four teams, Fresno Dulcich Tribe, Peoria Pirates, Orange County Cardinals and the South Dakota Rushmores are all 3-2. The Millennium Properties Pirates are 2-3 and are in fifth place. All of the Continental teams play crossover division games today.

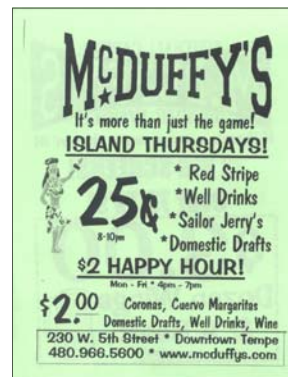
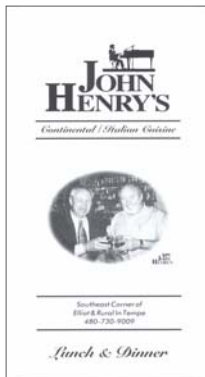
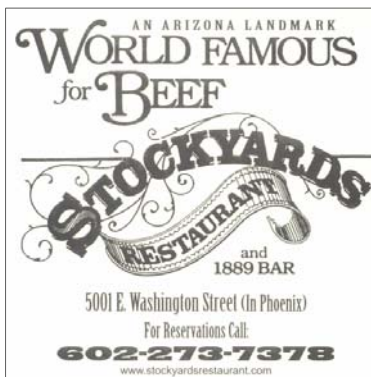
Just a decade ago, few would have considered Phoenix a hotbed for trendy restaurants. Yet these days the desert is cooking with cool chefs determined to make dining out a

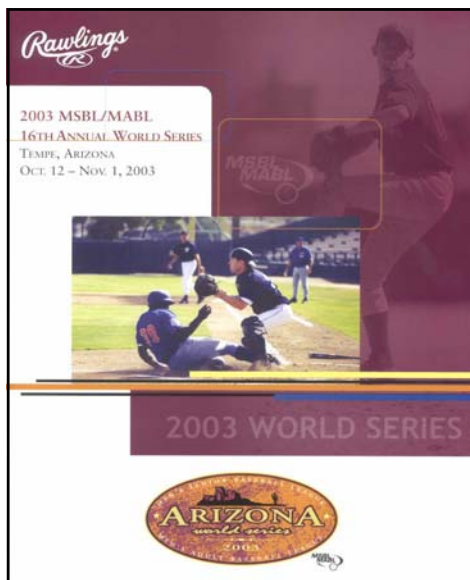
