New National Tournament Set For Palm Springs January 17th - 19th

Beginning in 2004, the MSBL will host another new national tournament, called the Desert Classic, to be held in Palm Springs, California, January 17th - 19th.

Four separate age divisions will be included in next year's inaugural event (18+ / 28+ / 38+ and 48+) while every team will be guaranteed at least three games. The tournament has room for 24 teams - 6 per age division. Baseballs, umpires, and field rental is included in the \$1400 team registration fee. A \$250 deposit is required to reserve a spot.

Hosting tournaments is nothing new to the MSBL/MABL, but this event will also include a golf tournament on Friday, January 16th, a first for an MSBL/MABL sponsored tournament.

So, in addition to baseball and golf, Palm Springs has so many entertaining attractions that you might have a problem deciding where to start. Great theaters, water parks, museums, balloon flights, sightseeing and star-spotting, Palm Springs has something to offer for everyone in the family.

High Stakes Games Today As MABL WS Concludes With Championships

Only four games left to be played in the 2003 MABL World Series, all championship games that are scheduled for today. This morning in the 18+ National Division championship game the Kansas City Titans (4-1) will take on the Tinsel Town Terror (5-0). Earlier in the week the Terror beat the Titans 10-5.

In the 18+ American Division championship game the Pacific Coast Braves (4-1) will play the undefeated Las Vegas Heat (5-0). During their pool play games the Las Vegas Heat out scored their opponents 55 to 23. The Pacific Coast Braves scored 42 runs while allowing 31.

The Chicago Lookouts (5-0) will square off against the Orange Co Astros (4-1) in the 18+ Federal Division championship game. Chicago was the division 2 winner, while the Astros finished in 2nd place in division 1. Yesterday the Lookouts scored 25 runs and allowed just 5 in their two playoff games while the Astros scored 9 and allowed 5.

In the 18+ Central Division championship game the Long Island Cardinals (3-0-2) will play the Inland Pacific Angels (4-0-1), both teams are unbeaten through seven games. The Cardinals beat the Twin City Giants and the San Antonio Orioles, while the Angels defeated the Colorado Spring Giants and the Daytona Beach Yankees in very close games yesterday.

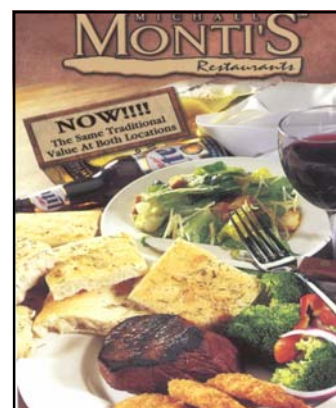
