MSBL National Adds New January Tournament To Schedule

Beginning in 2004, the MSBL will host another new national tournament, called the Desert Classic, to be held in Palm Springs, California, January 17th - 19th.

Four separate age divisions will be included in next year's inaugural event (18+ / 28+ / 38+ and 48+) while every team will be guaranteed at least three games. The tournament has room for 24 teams - 6 per age division. Baseballs, umpires, and field rental is included in the \$1400 team registration fee. A \$250 deposit is required to reserve a spot.

Hosting tournaments is nothing new to the MSBL/MABL, but this event will also include a golf tournament on Friday, January 16th, a first for an MSBL/MABL sponsored tournament.

So, in addition to baseball and golf, Palm Springs has so many entertaining attractions that you might have a problem deciding where to start. Great theaters, water parks, museums, balloon flights, sightseeing and star-spotting, Palm Springs has something to offer for everyone in the family.

Runs Allowed Category Just As Important As A Teams Winning Record

During the first two weeks of the 2003 MSBL / MABL World Series, several managers found out the hard way that the number of runs they allowed might make a difference in their teams playoff chances. The first tie-breaking category after head-to-head is runs allowed and all wildcard teams that finish with the same record are selected based on least runs allowed. So in addition to trying to juggle their pitching staff, managers need to keep current on the number of runs their team allows as well as other teams with the same record. Teams should always check the newsletter and or scorebook.com to make sure that their record and runs allowed is correct. The next tie breaking category is runs scored.

If your team is playing in a participation division it's important to make sure that the correct number of players are getting at least one at-bat per game. Only players who participate in pool play games may play during the playoffs and championships on Friday and Saturday. This years special guest speaker at the WS Awards Banquet (held Saturday night at the Rustler's Rooste - Pointe at So. Mountain) is Eric Burns of the Oakland A's.

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**Diary of an Aging Baseball Player**

It's All in the Name

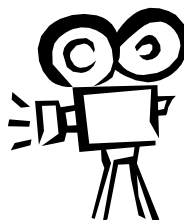
