

Teams from around the country that attend the annual MSBL/MABL World Series every year usually come with high expectations regarding their chances of winning a champion-ship title and great weather. Yesterday the 25 teams that began play in the tournament were not disappointed by the weather, which was perfect.

Every team in the 28+ National Division won one game on Sunday, so they are in a 5-way tie for first place. Talk about a competitive division. In the 28+ American Division the Chicago Rebels and Scottsdale Finest each finished the day with a record of 2-0. The OK City Braves and Grand Rapids-Koster & Devries game ended up in a tie.

In the 28+ Continental Division the Peoria Pirates picked up right where they left off last year, winning both of their games. The VABL Dawgs also went 2-0 to grab a share of first place with the Pirates at 2-0, in the 28+ Continental Division 1. 

MSBL / MABL National Tournament Calendar Set For The 2005 Season

The MSBL National office has announced the 2005 National Tournament schedule. The year's first tournament will be held at Disney's Wide World of Sports at Walt Disney World in Orlando,





Florida over the Martin Luther King Holiday Weekend. January 15th through the 19th. MSBL/MABL is proud to continue its relationship with Disney's Wide World of Sports. Disnev's complex serves as the Spring Training home of the Atlanta Braves.

Per Player Package includes: games at the Disney Complex, all baseball costs, awards, 5 nights accommodations and 3-day Park Hopper Pass (to be used at Animal Kingdom, Epcot, MGM and Magic Kingdom)

The Disney Holiday Classic offers three different age divisions, 18+, 28+ and 38+. In January of this year, the MSBL/MABL hosted the first ever Desert Classic in Palm Springs, California. It included a Golf Tournament on Friday (which was optional) and the games began on Saturday. This year the second annual Desert Classic will be held January 17th through the 19th. It offers four separate age groups, 18+, 28+,38+ and 48+.





The Cactus Classic will be held in Phoenix. Arizona for the third consecutive year, in conjunction with Major League Baseball Spring Training. So not only can you have a Spring Training of your own, but also watch your favorite players get ready for the 2005 season! This tournament will be held March 18th through the

21st. Three different age groups are offered, 28+, 38+ and 48+. Las Vegas is home to two tournaments, the Kickoff Classic held March 13th - 15th (18+ and 28+) and March 20th - 22nd (38+ and 48+). The Las Vegas Open is held over the Memorial Day Weekend, May 29th through 31st). This tournament offers 7 separate age groups, 18+, 28+, 38+, 48+, 58+ and Father / Son.



MSBL / MABL WS Home Run Hitting Contest

This year, two separate Home Run Derbys will be held on Friday night at Tempe Diablo Stadium. Players in the 18+ / 28+ divisions will get their opportunity to hit from 8:00p to 9:00p. The MABL HR Derby will start around 9:00p.

The entry fee will be \$25 (per player) and the first place prize will include a picture in HardBall magazine, an Easton aluminum bat, and a cash prize.

Home run contest rules are: Each player must provide his own bat and pitcher. During the first round, each player gets ten (10) swings. Only balls that clear the fence in fair territory will be counted. If players are tied after the first round, the players who have hit the most HRs will repeat the process in round two. The contest will continue until one player has hit more HRs than anyone else.

Players may enter the contest anytime until Friday night. The hitting order will be determined by when a player signs up. 



Atlanta Astros starting pitcher **Corey Tibbs** picked up the win in his team's opening game 11-0 victory over the Scottsdale Mudcats.




