The Facts About Hohokam Stadium

Hohokam Stadium (pronounced Ho-Ho-COM) is the city of Mesa's newest and largest baseball facility, a 12,500 seat stadium with complete support and training facilities, and serves as the spring training home of the Chicago Cubs. The stadium was built in 1996, and opened to the public for the first time for the 1997 spring training season. The new stadium was designed by HOK Sport of Kansas city, Missouri, designers of Baltimore's Camden yard, Cleveland's Jacobs Field and Coors Field in Denver.

While the Cubs are the most high-profile tenants of the facility, Hohokam Stadium is in use throughout the year for a wide variety of baseball tournaments and events, as well as many non-sports related activities, such as corporate meetings, weddings, commercial film shoots, and community sponsored special events.

Hohokam Stadium is located at 1235 N. Center Street, between Brown Road and McKellips Road in north central Mesa.
