Banasik And Tanner Inducted Into MSBL Hall Of Fame

WS Central Participation Rule Changed To Allow More Competitive Balance

The Athletics won the Father and Son National Division Championship game 4-3 on Sunday afternoon in 10 innings. San Jose tied the game in the top of the ninth with two outs and a runner on second. The Arkansas Diamonds won the Father and Son American AAA championship game 6-1 over the Massachusetts Cardinals, as their pitchers combined for a no-hitter. The World Trans Angels beat Team Sports Pro Cubs 8-4 to win the American AA Championship title. In the 65+ Division, the San Diego Padres outscored the South Dakota Rushmores 17-8 in a slugfest.

On Saturday night at the annual MSBL World Series Awards Banquet, Steve Sigler inducted two new members into the MSBL National Hall of Fame. Jim Tanner from Terre Haute and Joe Banasik from Houston were presented with the league's most prestigious awards in an emotional ceremony at the Rustler's Rooste. Dave Dunne, Hohokam Stadium coordinator, was inducted into the World Series Hall of Fame. World Series Umpire-in-Chief Dick Jolly presented Ken Mitchell (from Everett, Washington) with the esteemed 2005 Ed Carter Umpire Award for excellence both on and off the field.

Sunday night at the manager's meeting, Steve Sigler amended the Central Participation rule to read as follows: If a team has 14 or 15 uniformed players, all players must have at least one plate appearance. If a team has 16 or more players, they may elect to bat only 15 players. In the event that one team only has 13 players (and the other team has 15) both teams only need to bat 13 players. This rule's intent is to make it fair for both sides.

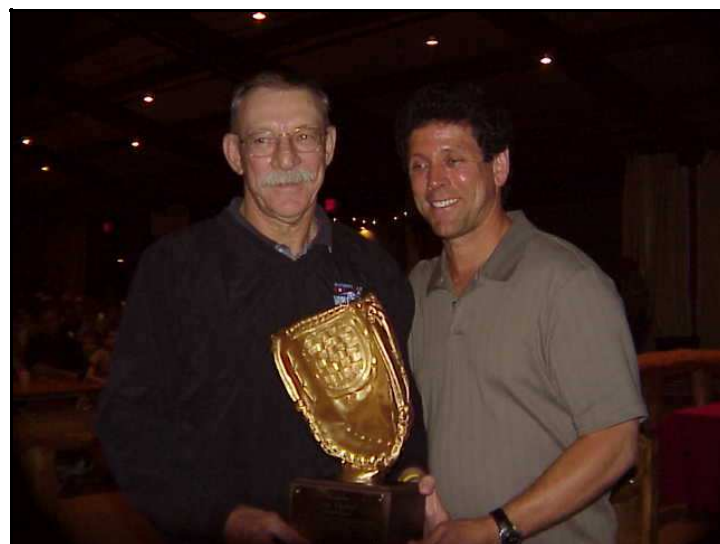

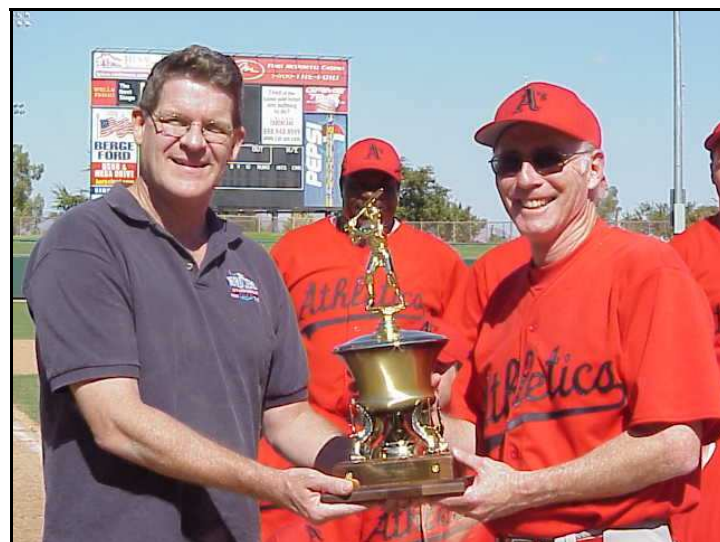
