Player Expelled From The Tournament For Misconduct At Papago Complex

Two years ago, the city of Phoenix spent five million dollars renovating the Oakland A's spring training facility, the Phoenix Municipal Stadium and the auxiliary fields at the Papago Sports Complex. Director James Vujs made it clear to the WS staff at that time that any player misconduct would result in the MSBL/MABL tournament losing the opportunity to play games at one or both of the facilities.

Last year the WS staff hired two-full time retired police officers to be on hand before, during and after all games played at both of the facilities. This year each manager was given written information regarding the consequences of any player or players that were caught urinating anywhere but in the restrooms at either complex.

On Wednesday night, an MABL player from the Daytona Beach Yankees became the first player expelled from this year's tournament for urinating next to the dugout and not in the *(continued on page 3)*

Continental Playoffs And Championship To Remain As Scheduled!

MABL Teams Get Off To A Fast Start On Day One Of The World Series Tournament By Tom Prendergast

Forget about that best two-out-of-three, would-be 28+ National Championship series - it's not going to happen. This reporter, it turned out, was a bit overzealous in his reporting of the new format in yesterday's WS Daily News. Turns out that not of all the teams felt they had the pitching to go into a series like that. Too bad. So it's back to the revised 28+ National / Continental playoff series that was announced on Saturday night at the managers meeting. That schedule (which can be found on page 2) has the top 6 teams advancing to the playoffs. The top two teams, the Valley Mets (5-1) and the Atlanta Astros (5-1), will play each other at 2:00p this afternoon for the 28+ National Championship. The loser of that game will bye into the Continental Championship game on Friday morning.

The Tri Valley Cardinals (3rd place) will play the Oklahoma City Braves (6th place) and the Tucson Cardinals (4th place) will take on the Grand Rapids Kosters & Devries team (5th place) at 10:00a this morning. The winners of those two games will play each other at 2:00p today. The winner of that game will play the loser of the 28+ National game. In other "news you can use", only about 20 MABL managers attended the special pre-tournament informational meeting that the WS staff puts on for each division. While these meetings can be a bit redundant for guys coming every year, the complex rules and what's important for a team to comprehend about qualifying for the playoffs is certainly need to know stuff! This year for example, the managers found out that the umpires would be keeping track of pitchers who appeared in games by writing their names down on the backs of the blue score cards. This way, even if they didn't get an at-bat they would (continued on page 2)

be listed officially somewhere, just in case a team would question them later on. One of the best questions brought up yesterday by a Central team manager had to do with teams that don't dress all of their players for every game. Steve Sigler's response questioned why a team would voluntarily play in a participation division, then not have all of their players available for a game? While that's not technically a violation of the WS rules, why would any team purposely limit their opportunities to win? What's the point in bringing a player to the tournament, and then not playing him? Who benefits by that? Additionally, the runs allowed category continues to be one of the most important playoff qualifying factors after a team's win / loss record. If your team is in a division where all of the teams don't play each other, then runs allowed is huge. Of course, let's also not forget about the courtesy runner rules. Each team can use two - and only two. Teams don't have the option of using a speed-up rule for the catcher / pitcher with two outs.


