Twenty years ago the closest that most of us got to the baseball field was when we were coaching our sons little league teams. After that article Steve Sigler's home phone didn't stop ringing. Seven nights a week he would be up past midnight talking to prospective players and would-be league presidents about how to set up a league and begin forming new teams.

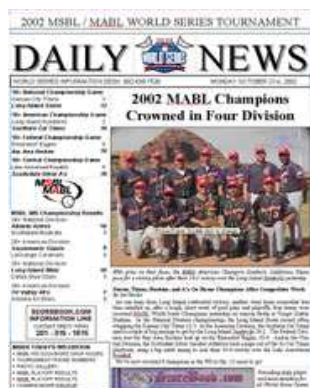
