38+ Central Wildcard Komax Masters Win Three Games To Reach The Finals

If Las Vegas had a betting line on the MSBL World Series (and I'm not suggesting that they don't) most of the time, the favorite would be the team with the better record in the pool play round. Yesterday the underdogs held their own and in a few cases, surprised the experts and their heavily favored opponent. After starting 0-3, the 38+ Komax Masters have been on a roll, winning their last three games to earn a wildcard berth and yesterday they won all three games to advance to the finals.

Down 5-1 in the bottom of the ninth, the 48+ Mountain Chicago Fire pulled off the best come-from-behind victory of the day, scoring five runs and defeating the Indianapolis Blues 6-5, to advance to today's championship game. In the 48+ Central Division, the wildcard Austin Express won three games and will play today for the championship.

The 55+ San Antonio Rangers shocked the number one seed Berry's Athletic Supply with a 2-1 victory in the semi-final game, while the heavily favored Detroit 50's squeaked by the Sacramento Rivercats 4-3. Don't forget, tonight the 2006 MSBL Awards Banquet will be held at the Rustler's Rooste, which has one of the best views overlooking the city.
