

2007 MSBL / MABL World Series "Live" Internet Broadcast Available On The Web By Tom Prendergast

Technology has transformed the way that we receive information in today's on-line and ever changing world. In an effort to try and keep our members more informed, we will broadcast a selected World Series game from Tempe Diablo Stadium each afternoon, "Live" via the National MSBL website.

This broadcast will begin each day at noon with a half hour pre-game show, Monday through Thursday, Arizona time. KC MSBL player and award winning radio personality Joel Becker will be the play-by-play announcer. At his side will be a representative from each of the teams that are participating in the game.

At the conclusion of the game Joel will be joined by a World Series staff member who will recap all of the days scores and up-to-date standings in each division.

50+ / 60+ Players Take Center Stage As 2007 MSBL World Series Opens *Aussie Aces Teams Travel 7000 Miles To Participate In This Years Tournament By Tom Prendergast*

The weather couldn't have been better as the 2007 MSBL World Series began with games in the 50+/60+ Wood Bat Divisions on Monday. In all 34 teams took the field yesterday under a bright blue sky without a cloud in sight. With the temperature in the mid 80's and a slight breeze, playing conditions couldn't have been better.

At exactly 12:02p yesterday afternoon the MSBL World Series began broadcasting a "live" webcast of the Printing Place Playboys vs Metro Rebels game from Tempe Diablo Stadium. Play-by-play announcer Joel Becker took center stage as he described the action on the field to the world wide web audience. This technological achievement was yet another first for the MSBL World Series, who continually strive to find new and innovative ways to improve the communication capabilities of the tournament. MSBL umpire Ken Vanderpoel conducted in game interviews with members of both teams between innings while WS staff members Jon Browar and Clyde Miller provided the listening audience with scores of other games as soon as they were reported to the office.

While most of the WS participants come from the continental United States this year several teams have traveled from Australia to participate in the tournament. The 7000 mile one-way trip takes about 22 hours by plane and crosses an international dateline and multiple time zones. Not only do these guys enjoy playing baseball, but they are extremely passionate about the sport and their desire to play against the best competition.










The 2007 MSBL / MABL World Series features five teams from Australia this year, including the 50+ and 60+ teams on hand this week.


