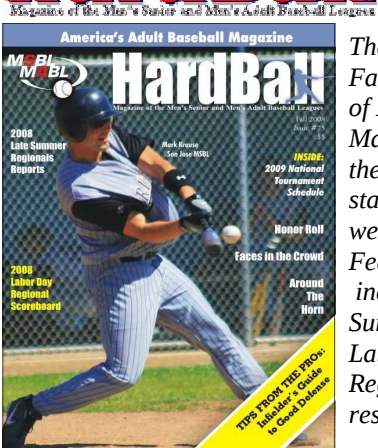

World Series Trade Show Wraps Up With Final Welcome Bar-B-Que For Week 3 Players

Summer just keeps on going at the 2008 MSBL / MABL World Series tournament. At 9:30a yesterday morning the National Anthem played over the Tempe Diablo Stadium speakers and minutes later the first pitch of the Father & Son National championship game took place. On a picture perfect day for baseball five more MSBL / MABL WS championships were won. At Hohokam Stadium the 65+ WB National San Diego Padres beat the Chicago Skyliners 10-7. A little bit farther east at the Red Mountain Complex, the Canada Snowbirds defeated the St Thomas Suns 15-8, to win the 65+ WB American title game.

At Tempe Diablo Stadium the Athletics played the Rhode Island Cardinals in the National Father & Son championship game and won 5-2. In the Father & Son Central game played at Maryvale Stadium, the Central Coast Bulls defeated the Las Vegas A's 7-4 to win their first title in their first World Series. But the days most exciting game was the F/S American final game between the Sacramento Tribe and the Maine Diamond Dogs. Scoreless through five innings the Dogs took a 3-0 lead into the seventh inning. Sacramento tied the score in the top of the eighth at 3-3. Maine scored the go-ahead run in the bottom of the eighth and then Dogs pitcher Matt Powers struck out the side for the 4-3 victory.

Also on Sunday 75 team managers showed up and picked up their WS merchandise for week 3, while the final Welcome Bar-B-Que took place in the left field concourse of Tempe Diablo Stadium. Sunday was also the final day of the Trade Show.

According to the Official Rules of Major League Baseball "Annotated", **Professional Interpretation** rule 4.10 states the following: *"In making a decision as to when to invoke the curfew, the umpire shall rule that an inning or half-inning starts immediately after the third out of the preceding inning is made."*

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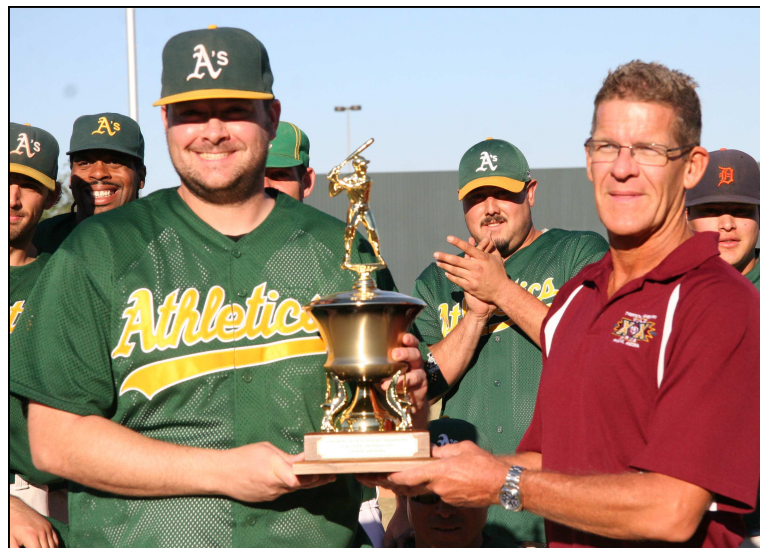
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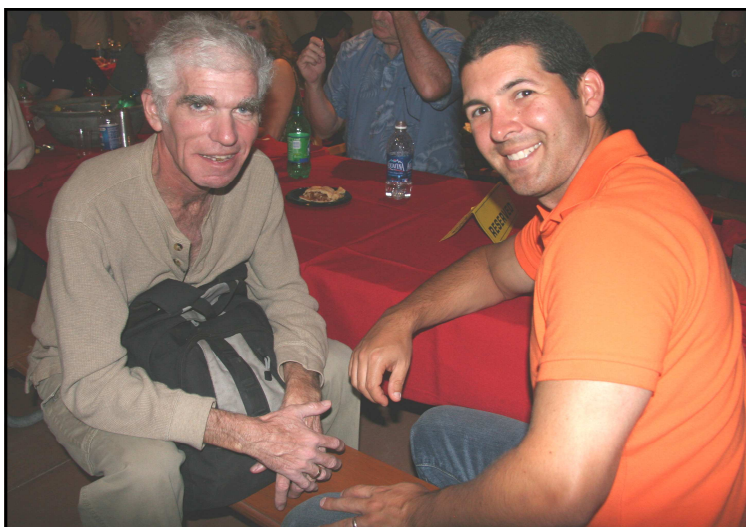
