35+ Central Playoff Format Remains The Same — Top 6 Teams

Thursday Night At World Series Central Busy — Teams Posted On Scorebook.com

The 35+ Continental playoff format will include the top four teams. In order for the Cascade Mariners or the South Dakota Rushmores to qualify for this division, they must have a pool play record of 4-2 or better to advance into the Continental playoffs. These two teams are only eligible for the Continental playoffs. If either team finishes 3-3 or worse, they will not qualify for either playoff.

The next four best records will qualify for the Mountain Division playoffs. The playoffs will be played at the Goodyear Complex on Friday October 31st. (See Continental & Mountain playoff schedule listed on page 2.) Both of the division championship games will be played on Saturday, November 1st.

Most every evening during the tournament the WS office is a busy place. That's especially true on Thursday nights. In an effort to notify the teams as quickly as possible that they have qualified for the playoffs, the staff will be updating the Scorebook.com website as soon as possible. Once all of the pool play games in that division have been completed we will be contacting all of the managers in that division notifying those teams who have qualified.
