Several Teams In Must Win Situations With A Playoff Berth At Stake

Wildcard Teams Likely To Be Determined By The Least Runs Allowed Category By Tom Prendergast

It's win or else today with a playoff berth on the line for the top teams in each division. In some cases a few teams today are really playing in what amounts to a playoff game. Because if they don't win, they won't qualify for the playoff round which begins on Friday. The first tie-breaker in each division is head-to-head play. However, if your team is in a crossover division or all of the teams with the same record didn't get a chance to play each other then the determining tie-breaker is runs allowed category. As teams begin the final day of pool play, it's a pretty safe bet that every teams has more than a few tired arms. But despite the tired legs and weary arms, players want to keep playing for as long as they can no matter what the pain or the odds. It's very likely that more than a few teams are going to end up with 4-2 or even a 3-3 record. More often than not, the determining factor for wildcard spots will be the least runs allowed.

The playoffs will be played at the Papago, Fitch, Goodyear, Autry and Tempe facilities. On Saturday all of the championship games will be played at the Tempe Diablo Complex. That evening the annual MSBL WS Awards Banquet will be held the Rustler's Rooste, located at Baseline and I-10, behind the newly remodeled Arizona Grand Hotel. Former major league player Maury Wills will be the guest speaker.




