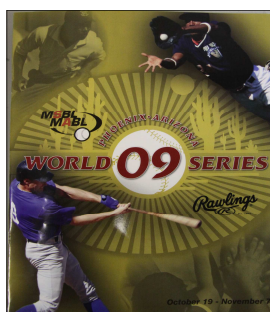
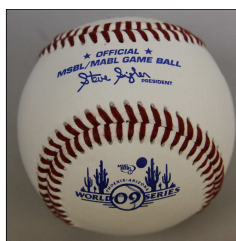

321 MSBL / MABL World Series Teams To Participate This Year

Despite The Economy MSBL / MABL WS Teams Increase By 21 Over 2008

The 22nd Annual MSBL / MABL World Series began with higher than normal temperatures for the month of October. That was no problem for the players who arrived this past weekend and began getting used to the warm weather during their team practices on Sunday. Monday the 50+ and 60+ Wood Bat Divisions began play at various locations throughout the greater Phoenix Metropolitan area. Almost every game this week will be played on major league fields or stadiums. A remarkable achievement considering how many teams and games will be played over the next three weeks.

This year 321 teams will be part of the largest amateur baseball tournament in the country. MSBL / MABL President and Founder, Steve Sigler was very happy (and proud) with the 21 team increase from last year. While the economy has shown some signs of recovery, overall things remain sluggish across the country. But the drawing power of the MSBL / MABL WS was a strong incentive to players who have been regular participants over the last 22 years.

Six games in four days, plus playoffs and championship games played in a very competitive and well organized environment on the very best fields remains a winning combination. The best souvenir a player can take home is still one that can't be bought. An MSBL / MABL WS championship ring has been the most sought after prize for the last 21 years. 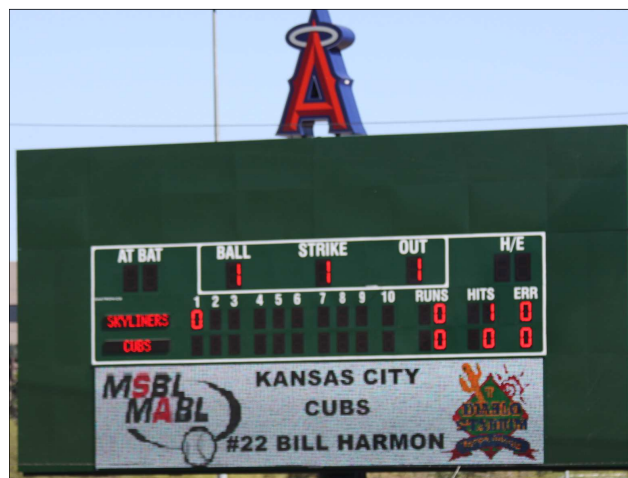

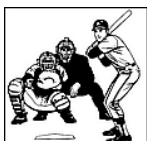

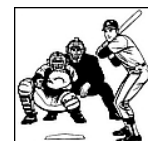


The new scoreboard (above) at Tempe Diablo Stadium includes a new video screen that displays the players name, number and team.
