MSBL National Hall Of Fame Increases

On the ten year anniversary of the MSBL (1998) the National Hall of Fame was created. That year 13 members were inducted that first year. Since that time, 47 members have been inducted into the National MSBL / MABL Hall of Fame.

While most of the inductees have been local league presidents, the group also includes major partners with the MSBL and support personnel. Induction into the National MSBL / MABL Hall of Fame is an acknowledgement of that persons hard work and dedication to their local league, over a sustained period of time.

Runs Allowed Category Huge Going Into Today's Final Pool Play Game

A quick glance at the standings for this week and you will find that most of them still have several different potential outcomes, based on today's games. Today for many teams these games will be just like playoff games. Without a doubt, the least runs allowed category will play a big part in determining which teams advance to the playoff round. (see the back page for a revision to the existing tie breaker rules).

In an effort to get more teams involved in the playoffs, the World Series office has added a 55+ American Division for the playoffs. The top three 55+ Central Division winners will join the 5th place 55+ National (Fog City 50's) to form the new 55+ American Division. (see the back page for the new 55+ National and American playoff schedules).

By creating this new division, three additional Central Division teams will qualify for the playoffs. Instead of the top three division winners receiving a bye, the 2nd place teams will advance directly to the second round. The 3rd place teams will play the wildcards along with the 4th place teams. One of the 3rd place teams will also receive a bye in the first round. (see the back page for the new 55+ Central playoff schedule).

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2009 MSBL / MABL World Series (Revised Tie Breaker Situations)

We are, again, using a point system similar to the NHL. A team is awarded 2 points for a win, 1 point for a tie and 0 points for a loss.

Our first tie breaker will always be head-to-head competition. If this does not break the tie, we will advance to the playoffs, the team or teams who have given up the least runs allowed in the preliminary round robin games.

For example:

- 3 teams are tied for a playoff position or positions. All three teams beat each other during pool play. Positions for these teams will be based on least runs allowed.
- 3 teams are tied for a playoff position or positions. Team A beat Team C and Team A and Team C did not play each other. Runs allowed will determine position.
- If Team C would be eliminated from the playoffs, the head-to-head for the remaining two teams would determine playoff position.

Where wildcard qualifiers contend for playoff status, only runs allowed will dictate playoff-qualifying status. For example:

6 teams finish with identical records, all to be considered as contenders for the 4-wildcard positions. 2 teams are from 1 division, 2 teams are from separate divisions, 2 teams are from another division (same). For the 2 teams from the same division, head to head competition will not count towards eligibility in the playoff qualifying status since all 6 teams did not play each other. Only runs allowed will be considered.

In the unlikely event of a tie in runs allowed, total runs scored will be used to determine the playoff team.
