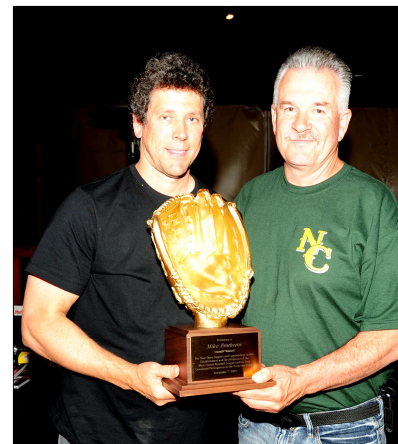

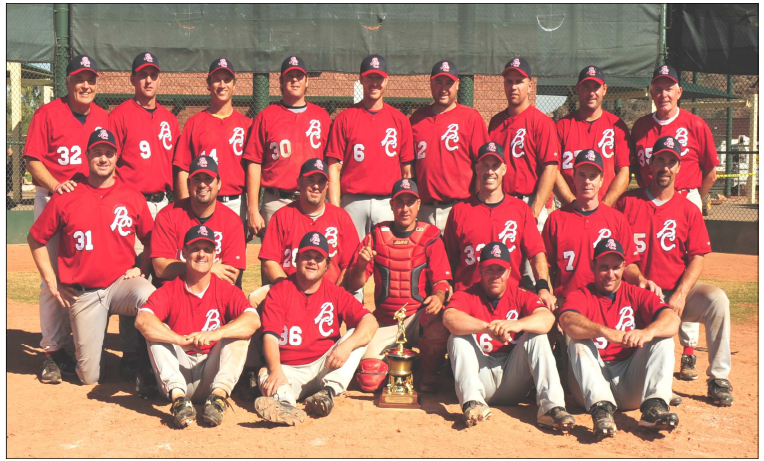
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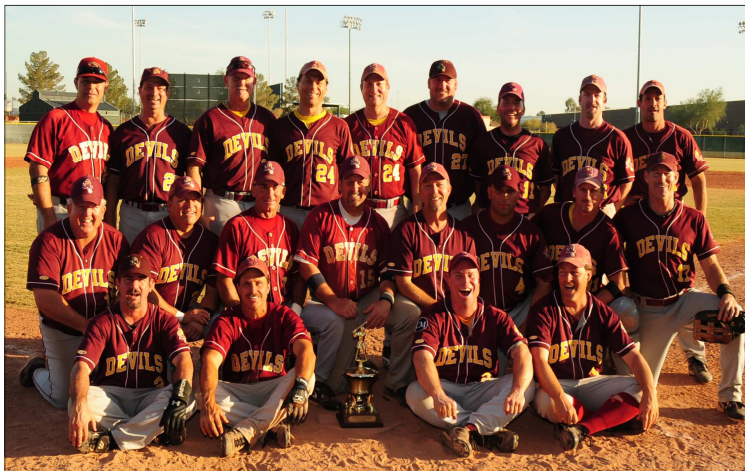
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45+ National Tri Valley 40's team won the championship game on Saturday at Tempe Diablo Stadium with a 12-3 win over So Cal.
