Tom Chandler (60+ Dodgertown)



Tom Chandler was instrumental in the nationwide development of MSBL. Along with Tom Hayden and other members of Dodgertown West, he hosted Steve Sigler's team of 19 Long Island

managers for a three game series in California. Sigler hit a grand slam home run in the final game to give the New Yorkers a series sweep, and shortly afterward the Dodgertown league was affiliated to the new national organization. As president of Dodgertown West, Tom has attended the MSBL World Series since 1995, and also played in MSBL tournaments in New Orleans, Canada, and the Virgin Islands.

Married to Francie, his wife of 34 years, he has two daughters in San Francisco, a daughter in New Jersey, and a son who is a doctor in South Carolina. Tom still works as a recruiting advisor for athletes to achieve scholarships to elite universities. With a World Series championship and several second place finishes to date, he intends to play as long as he is able to. His Dodgertown West players exhibit the true spirit of the MSBL.

320 MSBL / MABL World Series Teams To Participate This Year Temperature Heats Up As The Tournament Begins With 50+ / 60+ Teams

When mid-October arrives, it's easy to find MSBL and MABL players. Just check the best fields in the greater Phoenix area, where the World Series tournament games are played. For 23 years the Men's Senior and Adult Baseball League has been a fixture in the Valley of the Sun. This year is no different. An astounding 320 teams and over 6400 players continue to make this the largest amateur baseball tournament in the country.

This week the 50+ / 60+ Wood Bat Divisions play six games in 4 days, followed by playoffs on Friday and the championship games on Saturday. The desire for a championship title and the ring that goes with it brings back players year after year. On Wednesday the MABL teams begin play and Thursday the 25+ teams arrive.

MSBL / MABL WS Souvenirs and logo clothing are available every day at Tempe Diablo Stadium in the novelty shop behind the first base dugout on the concourse level. This week you can hear "live" broadcasts from selected games played at Tempe Diablo Stadium over the internet. Play-by-play announcer Joel Becker does a great job and makes the game sound a lot like a regular professional game. If you're within ear shot of the stadium you can also pick up the game on your local FM radio dial.

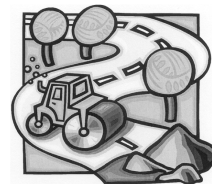
