Who would guess that the general manager of a copper mine in Chile, similar to the one recently in the news with the 33 trapped workers, would be celebrating a World Series cham-

pionship in 2006? Jerry returned from Chile in 2000 and responded to a newspaper ad from Skip Bradley. In addition to joining the San Antonio MSBL, he purchased a local Goodyear Tire dealership and two years later parlayed a friendship in the baseball league into a shared purchase of an electrical contracting firm from Larry Cheatwood, and they continue to play ball and operate their company together. Jerry's wife Ruby is as passionate and talented with her tennis as he is with baseball, and she supports his playing with up to three teams at a time. Their son Drew (33) also played in the SA MSBL and shared time on the Bombers in 1995 before moving away from San Antonio. In addition to Drew, Jerry has three other children, Lamont (35), Talia (31), and Christy (29). His San Antonio Bombers have won three championships, their latest with Jerry as manager (45+ National in 1996). With eight grandchildren, Jerry and Ruby may be supplying MSBL with new recruits for decades to come.
