Runs Allowed Category Very Important Factor In Central

World Series Manager's Packet Keeps Teams Informed About The Tournament

Without question, several teams playoff chances will be determined by their runs allowed. In the bigger divisions (with more than 7 teams) the head to head tie breaker doesn't come in to play, because every team didn't get the opportunity to play every team. So the next category is runs allowed. Inside the managers packet is a detailed breakdown (with specific examples) of how the playoff teams will be determined in case of a tie. This information is also listed on the new MSBL World Series website (under the Manager's Packet).

Additional information about the tournament rules can also be found, there and if your team is playing in a participation division, this is a must read for every manager. To date we've had 3 successful protests in the Central divisions, because a team did not get the required number of batters in a game. It's also important to understand that no game can end without recording the final out. For example, if there's time left on the game clock and the new inning starts, because we are using runs allowed as a tie breaker, that inning must be completed even if the home team is winning. Rule of thumb - if you start it, finish it.

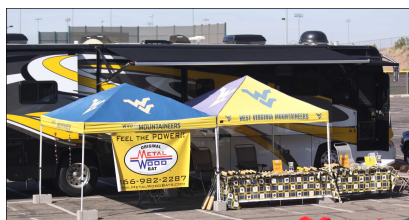

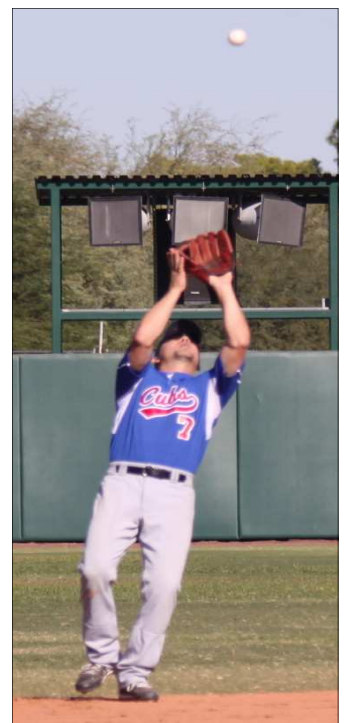
