But in 2007, he and his wife of 37 years, Judi celebrated a 55+ division crown. Inducted into the WS Hall of Fame in 2005, Jaffe remembers the intensity of playing six games in the three days format, and especially enjoyed his experience on the MSBL cruise.

Several Teams Need A Win Today To Have A Shot At Playing Friday Wildcard Playoff Berths Will Go To The Teams With The Fewest Runs Allowed!

Forget about tomorrow, the playoffs have arrived for several teams who if they don't win today, won't be advancing to the next round. And even a win might not guarantee a spot in the playoffs for some teams if their runs allowed are too high. The first tie-breaker is based on head-to-head competition. But that only applies when a team has played every team in the division. Teams in large divisions, that are in the middle of the pack, need to allow the least number of runs in order to advance. There's a example listed in the manager's packet that was handed out on Sunday.

The playoff pairings will be posted on www.msblworldseries.com as soon as all the results from each division are completed. If your team has a discrepancy with the runs allowed for your team posted on the website or on the standings page, please call the WS office and correct it, ASAP. You wouldn't want to wait until the last minute.

Saturday night the tournament hosts the WS Banquet, held at the Rustler's Rooste. This week's guest speaker is former and most likely future MLB manager, Don Wakamatsu. The evening gets under way with cocktails at 6:30p and dinner is served at 7:15p.

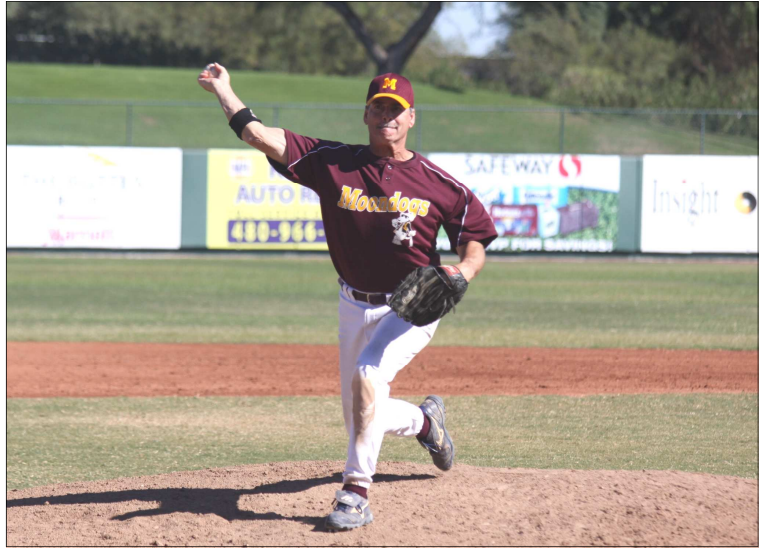

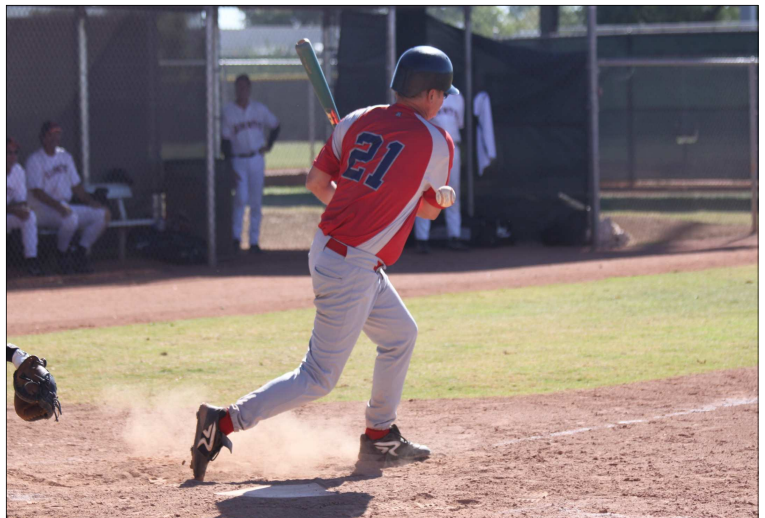
