### 55+ Central Division Team - Charlie Rose Forfeits Semi-Final Game

Unknowingly Violated Central Division Rules With 2 Former Professional Players By Tom Prendergast

In the movie, "A League Of Our Own", Tom Hanks delivers a great line when he tells his players, "there's no crying in baseball!" Truer words were never spoken. Along those lines I would like to add, "There are no secrets at the MSBL World Series!". To date we have had at least 8 official protests regarding suspected illegal players, or non-compliance of Central Division participation rules. I certainly realize what a challenge it is to put together a group of guys and come down here for a week to compete against your peers. Asking for money, trying to meet deadlines, paperwork that never seems to get collected and then dealing with last minute cancellations are all part of a thankless job. But, since everybody has to do it, we are all playing with the same set of rules. Not reading them properly, or at all, is not an excuse for being in violation of the rules. It is usually not the WS staff that makes the discovery when a team is not in compliance, it's one of your opponents, former teammates or even disgruntled players who feel the need to release themselves of this knowledge. In fact, sometimes it's the illegal player himself, informing the other team that he's only a year removed from the pro's and he really enjoys participating in this event. This information can quickly turn a loss into a win for a team that is in compliance and (continued on page 2)

This year the National MSBL / MABL office sent out the tournament rules in May, posted them on the website, and additionally issued the same information to the managers in the booklet they received at team registration. But for teams that have been coming here for many years, most of these rules were well known. If you select to participate in a Central Division, you must bat a minimum number of players per game. That's the prime directive for teams in this division. And while having a former ex professional player on the roster may seem like a great advantage, it could actually put your team in violation if you are in a division which limits or even prohibits former pros. It's safe to say I'm usually the last person to find out about these infractions. But when it's brought to my attention that a team is in violation of these rules, then it's my job to act and uphold the written rules, that have been published and put forth by the National MSBL / MABL office.

It's not personal, simply professional. When the office receives a protest call, we go to "red alert" status. A top priority of the WS staff is to make sure that every team gets a fair shot. We don't take sides and we don't rush to judgment, we just uphold the rules and regulations of the MSBL / MABL World Series tournament. So

yesterday when we received the call about the 55+ Central Division Charlie Rose team having more than one ex-professional player, we investigated the issue and determined that they did indeed have two (they are only allowed 1). During the investigation it became apparent to me that other teams were aware of this but felt it was in their best interests to not say anything, just in case they were going to play them later in the playoffs. Because so many teams seemed to be aware of this information, it was assumed that the WS staff and the National MSBL / MABL office were also aware and that we were allowing this to take place. Nothing could be further from reality.

Classics

The perception that the more players a team brings to the tournament (which equals more money paid) the more clout they have is false. Every team that participates gets the same fair treatment, and no team gets special conduct from the umpires or staff while they are here. This tournament would not be what it is today with that kind of tolerance. It's my belief that every team and every individual player is given the benefit of the doubt when an accusation arises. We don't take information that is posted on social networking sites necessarily as the truth. The sources we use are usually government related or affiliated in someway with Major League Baseball. Anything less would be a disservice to everyone involved.


