Appreciation leads to a spirit of giving back. Ralph Proulx grew up in challenging circumstances in upstate New York, and yet he has found success in many areas of his life. He does not take that lightly. Eager to do for others, in a spirit of giving back, he has spent much of his adulthood contributing to youth and adults in his community. For several years he was a mentor to young men through the Boy Scouts of America, as a result of what that organization did for him as a young man.

Then, as his girls displayed their athletic talents in softball, he got involved in coaching that sport. Long after they no longer played he continued to give of his time and energy so that others would reap the benefits of his experience. He now works with 13-14 year old boys on travel baseball team. His supportive wife Kara who's in the nursing profession, so the whole family has the same perspective on serving others. Kara has a brother and sister who live in Mesa, their daughter Melissa (26) lives in San Diego and younger daughter Kaila (17) looks forward to making the trip to the World Series so the whole family will get together in Arizona. Ralph started a small 4 team league (in 1988) after his brother Jim saw the Sports Illustrated article on Steve Sigler's beginnings in Long Island. Buffalo MSBL now sports a 25+ league of 10 teams and a 35+ league with six more. Ralph won his first championship in 2009 after more than ten years of coming to the tournament. Tempe Diablo Stadium holds a special place in his heart as his memories of the team's celebration there are special. He was honored with induction to the MSBL Hall of Fame in 2010. Team New Era is partially sponsored by Derby, a New York based company that supplies baseball caps throughout the world which also has the policy of giving back to the community. They are heavily involved with youth sports, parks development, and contributing to programs which enrich community life. That seems to be the perfect match for a manager, husband, father, coach, and mentor who loves giving back his life to everyone.

"There's never enough pitching to go around, regardless of how many guys you have on the roster", said one of the 60+ managers, after his team gave up an 8 run lead, only to end up with a tie. In fact, yesterday six games ended in a tie, which will no doubt have an impact on the final standings.

As stated in the hand out, that every team manager received when they registered their team on Sunday, the first tie breaker is always head to head. But when that doesn't apply, the next category is runs allowed. Without a doubt, teams that allow the fewest runs almost always put themselves in a much better position to qualify for a playoff spot. Especially for teams that are hoping to qualify as wildcard teams. Needless to say, every team should verify that the runs allowed (that are listed on page 3 and on the msblworldseries.com website) are correct. If they are not then that team manager should contact the MSBL WS office immediately to verify his teams actual runs allowed and scored totals, before Thursday evening.

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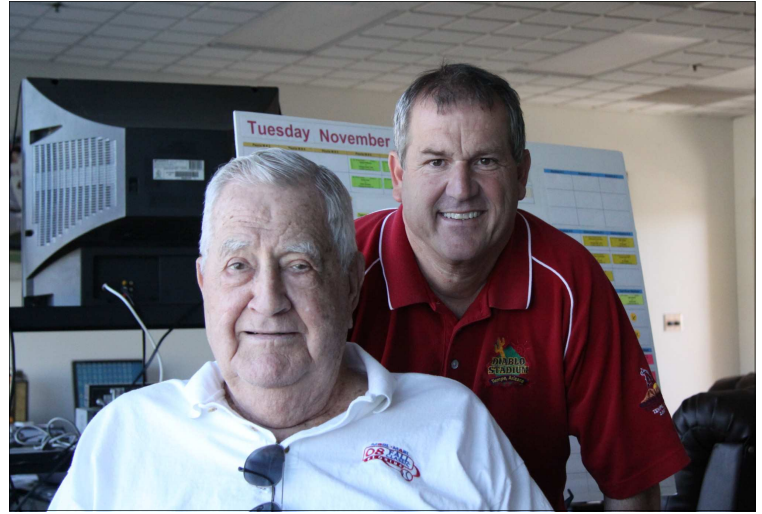
