Sometimes you get spoiled the first time. In 2001, the Dallas Hansens Energy Brewers were playing the Long Island Storm in the 30+ National championship game. Sam Kayea had added Gerry to his roster, and

this was his first World Series. With several team members of the Storm needing to get back home following the events of 9/11, they requested the Saturday championship be moved to Friday night. Dallas agreed, and found themselves trailing 7-1 with the Storm batting and bases loaded. It looked like this game was about to be out of reach. When a Storm hitter delivered a shot to the outfield with two out to clear the bases, Gerry noticed the batter has missed first base while watching his long fly drop in the outfield. They appealed to the umpire who ruled the same, and three runs came off the board. That set off a controversy and broke the rhythm of the game. Several innings later, Dallas came all the way back to claim a 14-13 victory. First time at the World Series, get a ring. Ten years later, Mecca is returning to Arizona as a two time champion (2001 and 2004), and twice runner up (2002 and 2007). He is also now the commissioner of the Dallas MSBL, a position he took over in the middle of last year. Gerry's wife Michele was there for the first year's championship and the loss in 2007, but prefers the spa and Scottsdale Art Festival to all those ball games. Daughter Ryan (8) and son Vincent (6) enjoy making the trip to the desert as a vacation and break from school. As an I.T. guy for 11 years with Dr. Pepper Snapple group, Gerry finds baseball to be a welcome release and enjoyable hobby. A former softball player before discovering MSBL, he has decided to sign up for a softball team again, but this time to use it as a method of recruiting new players for adult baseball. He told Steve Sigler that he considers himself an innovator, and believes this can encourage new growth in the local league. The Dallas market has several associations competing for players, field space, and legitimacy. When (continued on page 2)

Wildcard Spots Normally Go To The Teams With The Fewest Runs Allowed! By Tom Prendergast

Wow what a week of baseball! And you can forget about tomorrow if you don't win today. For all practical purposes the playoffs have arrived for several teams who find themselves in a must win situation, or else they won't be advancing to the next round. In some cases even a win might not guarantee a spot in the playoffs for teams if their runs allowed are too high. The first tie-breaker is based on head-to-head competition. But that only applies when a team has played every team in the division. Teams in large divisions, that are in the middle of the pack, need to allow the least number of runs in order to advance. There's a example listed in the manager's packet that was handed out this past Sunday to all team managers.

The playoff pairings will be posted on www.msblworldseries.com as soon as all the results from each division are completed. If your team has a discrepancy with the runs allowed for your team posted on the website or on the standings page, please call the WS office and correct it, ASAP. You wouldn't want to wait until the last minute.

Hutchinson, manager of the Quad City Blasters has been playing and managing now with his friends from the heartland for 22 years. The core of his team has been together for a long time. Men grow up coaching their sons, then stay involved as their grandsons learn the game. They share MaidRites and root beer. But he is still deeply involved in the game. Playing in a small 18+ league at home, they pick up enough young guys to be competitive, show up every week and continue to love their time on the diamond. Where kids began playing ball on empty lots with wooden bats that were repaired with small nails and electrical tape. Where the kid who had a real baseball was everyone's best friend. Married for 41 years to his wife Pat, their 3 children have given them 8 grandchildren, the way it should be. Retired from UPS, Mike has taken the opportunity to play in other MSBL regional tournaments and enjoys making new friends through baseball. He says he might start umpiring next year. He recalls the World Series tournament when rain delayed so many games that his team got to play in the finals....at midnight. The family has always shared his love for baseball, and Mike remembers when one year in Arizona his junior high aged son was reluctant to leave the hotel hot tub. Seems a Hawaiian swim team was sharing that space and baseball somehow wasn't quite as important. Sit down and have a talk with Mike Hutchinson. You will get a real sense of what is good about our country. Bring your glove. He'd love to play a game of catch while you talk.
