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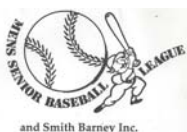

Home plate umpire, Clifford Flenoy suffered heat exhaustion during his second game at Tempe Diablo Stadium and left the field in an ambulance as a precaution. He was resting comfortably at Tempe St Lukes after receiving some fluids intravenously.
