He has accumulated 335 career victories for his efforts. Pat was honored to play golf with his baseball hero, Harmon Killebrrew during his broadcaster years with the Twins. He enjoys the unpredictable nature of the game, and points out that something unusual, weird, or even stunning seems to happen in every game. He was managing a close game once during a hotly contested league race and looked out to right field and saw there was no one playing the position. Later, when he asked his player where he went, he said "I had a date!"




