Jerry Spencer

(47+ San Antonio Bombers)

During the summer of 2000, Jerry saw an add in the newspaper for an adult baseball league tryout in San Antonio and after the workout was invited to join the Rangers.

Since that time the MSBL has become a very big part of his life. He took over managing the 45+ San Antonio Bombers in 2005 and has attended either the WS or the Fall Classic every year since 2002. He's been married to his wife Ruby for 19 years, and they have four children and 10 grand children. Jerry and his son Drew will be playing together on the Bombers 35+ team in week three this year.

During his MSBL playing career Jerry's had the opportunity to meet several well known celebrities along with some former professional players. To some degree he has patterned his baseball career after his hero, Ryan Nolan (without the 90 mph fastball), he says. And when he's not playing baseball, Jerry runs his own tire company (a Goodyear tire dealership) in Universal City, Texas.

Well liked and admired by members of the league, National MSBL President, Steve Sigler asked Jerry to take over as the San Antonio League President in 2014. Some pretty big shoes to fill as he replaces Skip Bradley, who's been in charge for the last 20 years.

When asked what is the most important reason for playing baseball in the MSBL, he answered that, "outside of my family, the people closest to me came into my life through my participation in the MSBL". He goes on to state that, "my Bomber teammates have become my brothers and we participate in many activities both related and unrelated to baseball". Before his teams game yesterday morning, Jerry was selected by the MSBL for induction into the World Series Hall of Fame.

While head-to-head is always the preferred tie-breaker, when three or more teams are involved and they've all defeated one of the other teams, then the runs allowed category is necessary, and the team that allows the fewest runs (regardless of the division) advances.

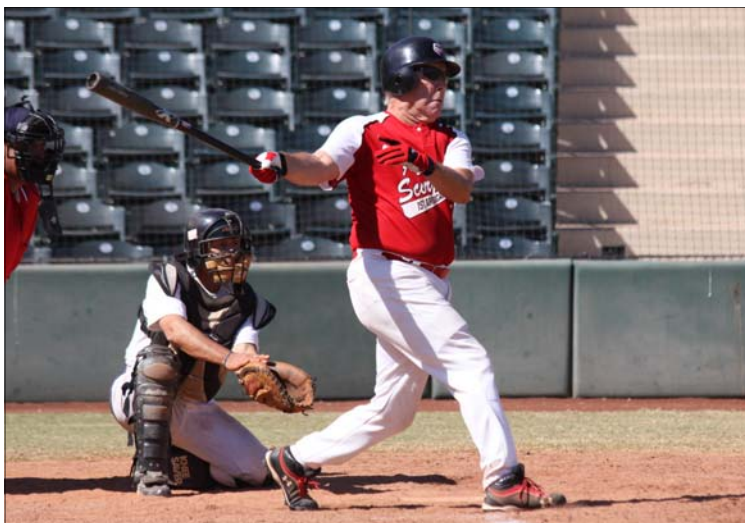

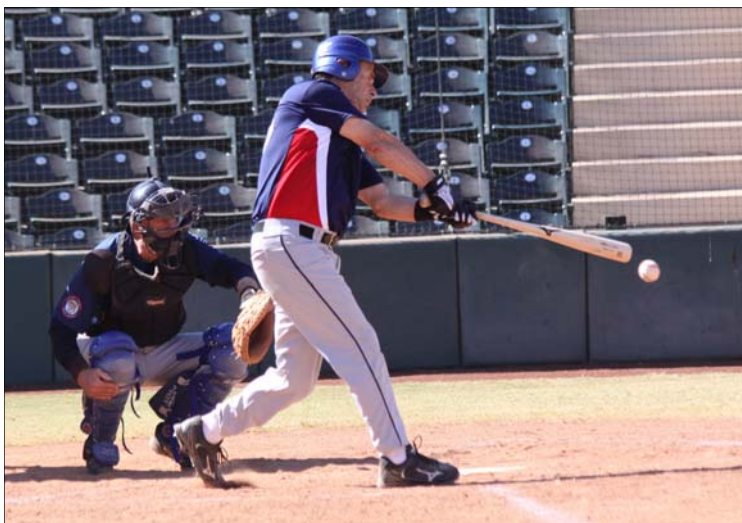
