WS Website Software Not Showing Points For Ties Or Runs Allowed

In an attempt to keep on offering up to date technology, the MSBL National Office has reached an agreement with a company that provides internet tournament software that allows the tournament staff to offer "real" time scoring updates. For example, as soon as the score is reported, the results are posted on the leagues website. Needless to say there's some great benefits to having that kind of ability, especially when the great majority of our players have smart phones or I Pads that allow them to monitor the site at a moments notice. One of the most frequent request that the national office receives each year is, "can we get an app for the website?" This new company is going to provide an app that will satisfy that request.

However, in the meantime the current software does not show ties or runs allowed in the team standings box. You can see your record, complete with ties and runs scored and allowed, but you have to manually add your teams scores and all of your opponents scores to get totals. And since runs allowed is a tie-breaking category, it's pretty important. So for now check the standings page in the WS Daily News or call the WS office.

Courtesy Runner Question Resolved As 55+ Division Teams Begin Play

If we gave the managers a quiz on the special MSBL / MABL rules, I'm betting most, if not all would score an A+. This is a group well schooled on the art of using these special rules to their advantage whenever possible, and why not! So when the 2013 MSBL WS managers packet omitted the 55+ teams, regarding courtesy runners, we had some confused skippers. The official scorebook handed out to every team lists the courtesy runner rule correctly, that allows 3 for all divisions 55+ and older. There's no need to call the office or lodge a protest on the field over this, team managers and officials should simply include it in their pre game meeting at home plate. And if it comes up during a game, call time out and get the correct guy running the bases. No games will be overturned on appeal because of a courtesy runner violation that goes unreported.

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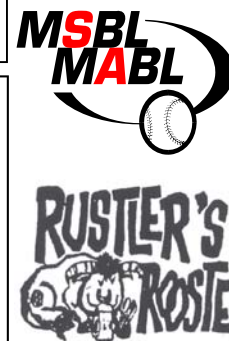
