Runs Allowed Category Always Important For Playoff Qualifying Teams

Teams Spending \$50 On A Possible Protest Isn't Always Money Well Spent! By Tom Prendergast

Halfway through this years MSBL / MABL World Series one thing hasn't changed. Teams that allow the fewest runs are normally the ones that advance to the playoffs. While head to head matchups are important, in some of the bigger divisions all of the teams don't play each other so runs allowed is used as the tie breaker. Same thing with the wildcards, who usually come from a different division. As a rule of thumb, you can never have enough pitching.

While a few teams have had some success with protests, it's not like in the NFL, where the coach gets to throw the red challenge flag. Our procedure is a bit more complicated! A couple things to remember before taking out that \$50 bill and handing it to the home plate umpire. A winning team cannot lodge a protest in order to achieve a 9-0 forfeit win. Only a losing team will have the opportunity to do that. And just a reminder that batting out of turn, the use of the wrong courtesy runner or failure to write down a pitcher's number on the line up card will not result in a win for the losing team. Common sense should always be your best guide.
