Sacramento Royals Whitewash Fort Worth Phillies 12-0 in 55 Mountain Division MSBL World Series Championship

Good defense and dominating pitching typically wins baseball games. That was the case at **Cubs Park**, the Spring Training home of the Chicago Cubs, on Tuesday. **Jerry Tuman** pitched a complete-game 12-0 shutout as the **Sacramento Royals** beat the **Fort Worth Phillies** in the **55 Wood Mountain MSBL Championship**. **Bruce Anderson, Steve Welch, Phil Adams, Bobby Wooden, Darryll Foster, Mark Shillinburg and Tim Burkitt** contributed two hits apiece for the Royals, who finished 6-1 in the tournament and had 20-hits total in the final game. **Tuman**, of **Gilbert, Ariz.**, scattered 10 hits, walked three and struck out five. The Royals righty stranded 13 base runners and saw his defense turn three double plays. 94 of Tuman's 141 pitches were strikes.

Most players remembered Alan "Navarro" Silver mainly as a good person and secondly as a very good ball player. But make no mistake: the man could play. "Alan and I go way back to 1999 in the Redwood Empire Baseball League," said Giants manager Don de Cordova. "Alan was a pitcher and third baseman and a very good hitter." Tim Ryan confirmed Alan's pitching ability. "For one 70 years of age Alan could throw the ball harder than most in their 50s," he said. "He wasn't just a thrower, he was a pitcher."
