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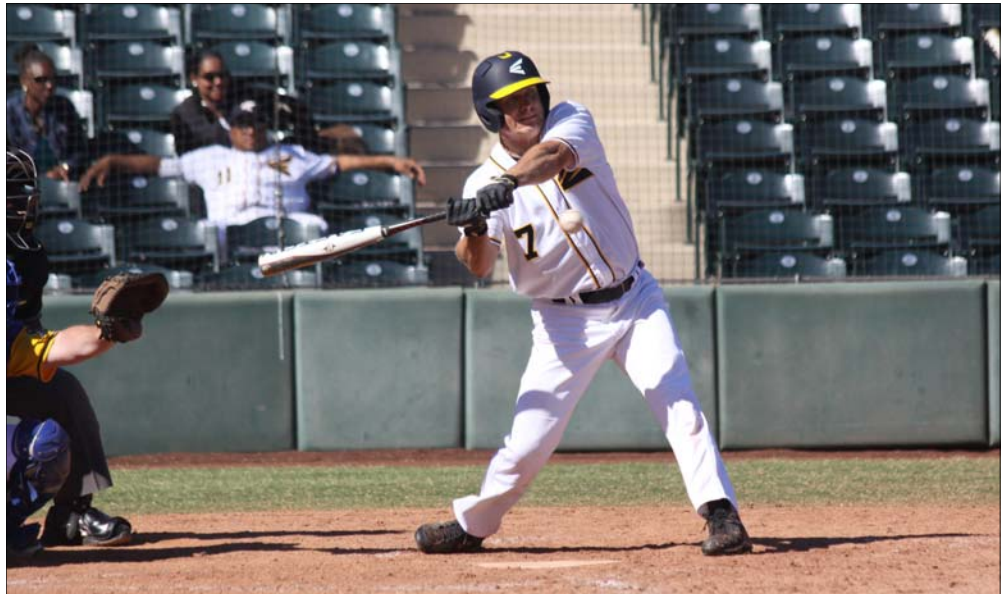

Wounded Warrior Softball Team To Play Exhibition Games At 2015 WS

Next year, during the 2015 MSBL / MABL World Series we are excited to announce that the Wounded Warrior Softball team will be playing several exhibition games against various all star, veteran laded MSBL/MABL squads. In September, the national office issued a press release announcing that the country's premier amateur baseball league for adults 18 years of age and older, was partnering with The Wounded Warrior Amputee Softball Team, Inc. ("WWAST"). They are a softball team like you've never seen. Nearly thirty veterans and active-duty soldiers have come together to play for the WAAST barnstorming around the country playing able body teams. As their name suggests, everyone on the team was injured while serving their country. Their mission is to educate and inspire the public through their play and demonstrate that "Life without a Limb is Limitless." This remarkable team has been featured on HBO, ESPN, NBC and Sports Illustrated, just to name a few. The WWAST is a 501(c)(3) public charity whose mission is to raise awareness, educate and inspire the public about the strength and resiliency of our wounded warriors, showing how a positive attitude, commitment, dedication and perseverance allow them to overcome any obstacles. The Team is comprised of veterans and active duty servicemen who have served our country in the Global War on Terrorism, in Iraq and in Afghanistan. They now travel the country playing able-bodied teams in competitive, celebrity and exhibition softball games, bringing their special brand of softball, courage and of course inspiration. WWAST athletes are examples of amputees who continue to push the limits of modern prosthetic technology with more and more applications. Of course, their dream would be the return of all of our soldiers from harm's way without the loss of life and limb. Until such a time, the vision is to support and honor our soldiers and veterans sacrifices, and to show other amputees and everyone who sees or hears about them that life without a limb is limitless.

Three 45+ Cactus San Francisco Giants Players Have Played In Every World Series Amazing Streak Continues Again This Year For The 27th Consecutive Year!

The MSBL San Francisco Giants from the Bay area, managed by Brian Willis, play very competitively in the 45 Cactus division in Arizona. A big part of that is because they are all pretty darn used to playing together. Teammates Pat Carrol, Ray Allen and Rob Goldstein have been coming down to the MSBL World Series in Arizona every single year since its inception in 1987. "I was 32 years old back then and we played in the 30 and over division," said the 58 year old Carrol. "We went three and three in our first year, got hooked and have come back ever since."

59 year old Rob Goldstein has been coming down every year as well. "We finally won our ring after 20 tries," said Goldstein. "We were the Dragons back then and we won in the 50 American division and then won again the next year and then again in Florida the following year. We were on a roll."

Ray Allen is the 57 year old final piece of the trio who has also been down every year since the MSBL World Series inception. "We played for different

teams for a few years initially but found each other eventually," said Allen. Ray was asked what his favorite moment was in his years of coming down and it took him the same two seconds to answer with the exact same comment as his partners Pat and Rob. "That's easy. It was our first ring with the Dragons after trying for 20 years. We had been coming down together for all those years and we won it together. That was very special."

The Giants are 2-1 so far this week and nobody knows where this week will lead them.
