MSBL World Series Tie Breakers - Head To Head And Then Fewest Runs Allowed
Wildcard Teams Can Come From Any Division - Reseeding Takes Place After Each Round

The playoffs are upon us. Pool play games end today and so for many teams the playoffs have already started. Bubble teams not only have to win but try and keep their opponents runs to a minimum. That's easier said than done. Not only does a manager have to keep an eye on the starting pitching, but every player is required to get a couple plate appearances and a pitcher needs to record three outs (during pool play games) in order to be eligible to participate in the playoffs. In the participation divisions a minimum of 14 players need a plate appearance if the game goes 9 innings. So there's a lot to contend with. Sometimes the difference between qualifying for the playoffs and not advancing is one run. Do you save an arm and take a chance on winning but giving up two many runs? Tough call but sometimes a manager has to roll the dice. The standings on the MSBL / MABL National website (powered by Pointstreak) sometimes don't show the correct order of teams and that can cause anxieties and problems (mostly for me), especially when (continued on page 3)

your team is listed as the third place team (and two other teams have the same record). In the division the first tie breaker is head to head. If all three of the teams with the same record didn't play each other, then the determining factor is fewest runs allowed. The wildcards are selected from teams who have the next best records in the overall division. In this case its record then fewest runs allowed.

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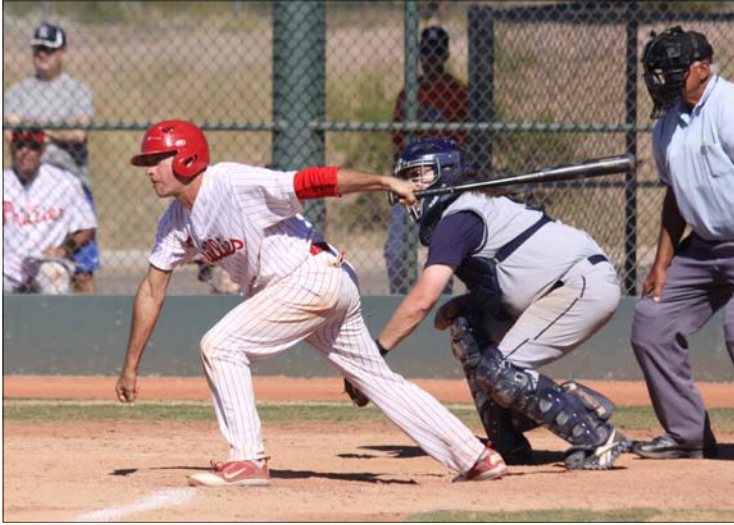
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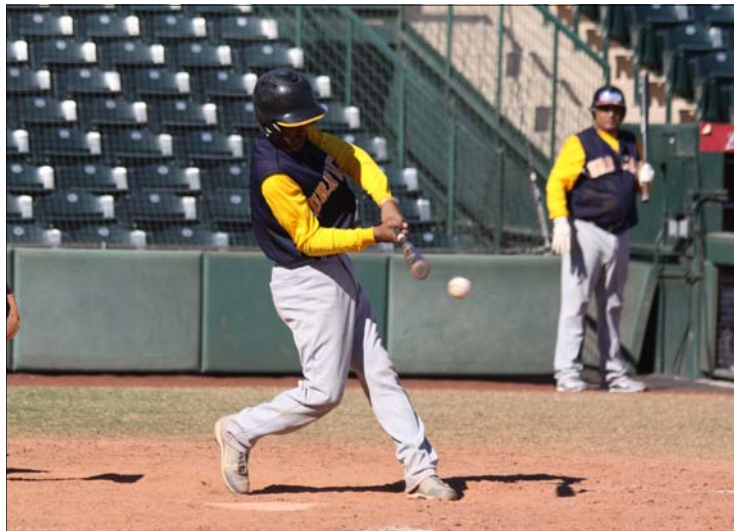
