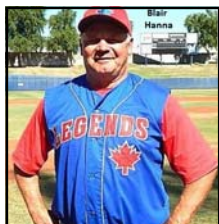

The 18+ WB National Division Paso Robles held on for an exciting 5 - 3 win over the Santa Clara Twins yesterday at Tempe Diablo Stadium to capture the championship trophy.

18+ National Division - Paso Robles 5, Santa Clara Twins 3

Paso Robles (6-2) got a complete game from hard-throwing right-hander Erik Draxton to beat the Santa Clara Twins 5-3 in the 18U+ National Division Championship of the 2016 MSBL World Series at Tempe Diablo Stadium. Draxton allowed eight hits, struck out eight and walked four, while Brandon Williams went 3-4 and Javier Gamboa added two RBI for the Central California-based champions. After allowing two runs in the sixth, Draxton struck out the side in the seventh and pitched a perfect ninth to cement the win. Derek Eaton, who allowed four runs in five innings, suffered the loss for the Twins.

18+ Central Division - DTB Yarddogs 6, Santa Rosa Rose Buds 3

The San Gabriel Valley, Calif.-based DTB Yarddogs scored six runs in the sixth and rode of the arm of right-hander Mario Rodarte to beat the Santa Rosa Rose Buds at Tempe Diablo Stadium in the 18U Central Division Championship of the 29th MSBL World Series. Rodarte, named the MVP, pitched a complete game, scattered 15 hits, struck out two and walked one. Ramiro Perez and Jose Caudillo both had two RBI for DTB. Mike Miller, who struck out 12, pitched all nine innings for the Rose Buds.

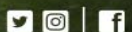
