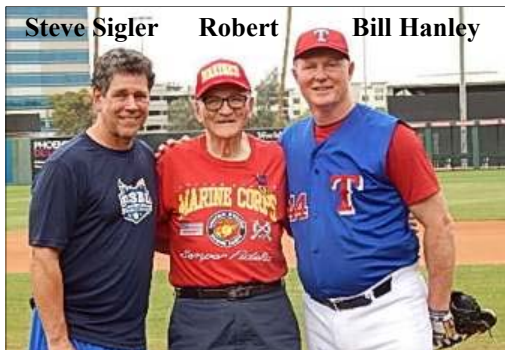

MSBL WS Batting Order Misconceptions Shared Position & The Courtesy Runner

Most of our special rules are created to either assist the manager in order to help get more players into the offensive lineup or to give relief to any player who has a nagging minor injury, and keep him in the game offensively. These special rules are also designed to help participation division managers to get 14 players at least one at bat while preserving the manager's offensive game plan. So going forward, teams can use either the courtesy runner or the shared batter position, not both! And most importantly it's up to the manager to communicate these lineup choices before the game. The offensive lineup needs to be exchanged before the game at the home plate meeting, and courtesy runners need to be designated at that time. No need to call in a protest on these violations. If the wrong courtesy runner is on base, get the correct one. And if it's the wrong batter - it's simply a batting out of turn, punishable with an out.

MSBL Expands The 55+ WB Central Playoffs From 6 To 8 Teams

Heatwave Continues Into Week 2 - Several Players Affected By Dehydration

In a press release issued by the National MSBL office on Monday, the 55+ WB Central playoffs have been expanded to 8 teams. The new playoff schedule will allow 8 of the 11 teams to advance to the playoffs. (see page 2 for new schedule)



A week into the tournament, daytime temperatures continued in the 90's, causing many heat related problems, the most serious has been dehydration. Yesterday afternoon after his game on Tempe 2 in the morning, St Paul Saints player, Pat Fynes passed out and collapsed. Quick action by Tri Valley Giants spectator, Kathy Schat (she's a physician), resulted in immediate care for Pat, and she requested that the paramedics be called. Kathy recognized his symptoms as dehydration. These included dizziness, dry mouth and skin, low blood pressure and rapid heart beat. Within 10 minutes, the Tempe Fire Department arrived and took over caring for him. After 15 minutes they had brought his color back into his face and he gave the thumbs up sign to his concerned teammates. As a precaution, he spent the night in the hospital.

Before they left, the paramedics suggested that all players should be consuming plenty of fluids, including rehydration drinks, water, juice, or sports drink to replace lost fluids and minerals. Consuming plenty of water is a must when you are participating in any outdoor sports, especially in this weather. 10-12 glasses of water per day is recommended!

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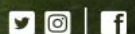
