Mike Cadenazzi: WS Merchandise Distribution 'Man Behind the Scenes'

Mike Cadenazzi is the distribution manager for the MSBL World Series. What is the distribution manager, you ask? If you have ever wondered how the MSBL merchandise distribution is coordinated for all of the team handouts for each and every player, as well as all trophies, awards, shirts, bats, hats, gloves, bags and the basic kitchen sink, just go see Mike. Mike and his main assistant, Sam Kayea, make sure all large equipment bags are stuffed and ready for distribution at each week's manager check-in. Their huge bag includes three dozen baseballs, scorebooks, and a special gift for each player, which this year is a nice cooler bag with the World Series logo.

"Steve Sigler always makes sure the player gets a nice gift," explained Mike. "In the past he has given everyone batting gloves, shirts, hats and everything in between." Coordinating this effort certainly includes many helpers, said Mike.

"I generally get in about Wednesday before the first weekend and get a U-Haul to cart everything over here to the stadium from our storage facility, this year about 500 boxes of stuff. It takes an army of people to help so I generally call for all hands on deck."



Mike is also in charge of seeing that all of the champions and runners-up receive their various prizes, and also that the trophies are coordinated for the correct divisions and that championship hats and the MSBL Championship banner is ready for the photo op after the big game. "Steve Sigler decides who gets what," said Cadenazzi. "It varies by age group and division. I have sheets for each winner that explains what they get in the way of awards and prizes and I make sure they get it."

What are some of the prizes given away this year at the 29th edition of our World Series? "We have wind shirts, dri-fit shirts, hats, bat bags, catcher's equipment

bags, special souvenir bats, some entry discounts for next year and even a few regular fielder's gloves from a catalogue. It varies and Steve decides who gets what and then lets me know. Of course most division winners get a ring on top of everything and the second place players generally receive a nice t-shirt of some kind."

When I first saw the two storage areas at Tempe Diablo Stadium that houses all of these items, I was speechless. Row upon row of boxes stacked to the ceiling and chuck full of items to be given away to the players and champions. Hundreds of thousands of dollars worth of merchandise to all be handed out to each and every participant, manager and champion. This is why 320 teams and thousands of players circle their calendars every year and head to the desert in October to play in the greatest show on dirt!

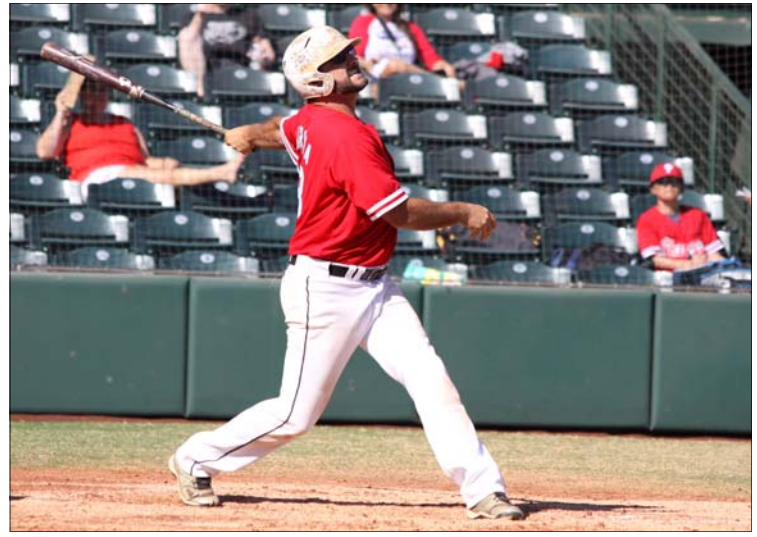
