#### Pat Thompson (St Paul Saints) 2016 MSBL World Series HOF

Pat Thompson grew up
in El Paso, Texas and
graduated from Texas
Western College (now
UTEP) before moving to
Albuquerque and then
later, Minneapolis with
Associated Press. He
covered major league



baseball for 15 years with AP and the St. Paul Pioneer Press. After starting a career in public relations in the mid 1980s, he founded the Eden Prairie, Minnesota, Lions Tap Over -35 team, which he managed for 28 years and recorded 350 victories. Just this summer, he was enshrined into the Minnesota Senior Men's Amateur Baseball Association Hall of Fame. The highlight of his baseball career was participating and managing the St. Paul Saints in the MSBL World Series. He also played on the New England Red Sox and El Paso Tejanos in the MSBL World Series before founding the Saints in 2010, a year they finished up as a runner-up in the 60+ Central Division championship game. In 2015, the Saints swept through the 65+ Central Division for their first MSBL championship with a sparkling 8-0 record. This year, Pat organized three Saints teams to play in the MSBL World Series 70s, 65s and 60s divisions with almost 60 players headed to this year's tournament. As a sidelight, he also writes Senior Baseball Soup, a blog about senior baseball plays and their sometimes zany pursuit of excellence. "While winning is always very satisfying, there is such great satisfaction meeting players from across the United States and a few other countries," said Pat. "Baseball is such an intriguing, beautiful sport that never

Angels manager Roberto Ramos decided to take a chance on entering the new 40-over Mountain division, recently added to the World Series division arsenal in an attempt to bridge an age gap between current 35-over and 45-over divisions. The Angels won the whole thing on Saturday so it is safe to assume that Roberto likes the new division. "We won our last championship in 2014 by the score of 10-4," said Ramos. "Today we won by 10-4. I guess that score and this division is going to be lucky for us." So why tackle the new division? "Actually I have four teams here this year. The 18's, 35's the 40's and 25 and over next week. The teams are basically the same guys so we were happy to have another opportunity to play." 


