Randy Enns - WS Hall Of Fame



Randy Enns has been an MSBL / MABL World Series attendee since the early 2000's when he was first played for the Columbus Yankees in the 35+ over division. He had such a good time that when he returned to Canada he immediately started assembling a team for the 35+ over central.

"We struggled for a couple years going 1-5 and 2-4 in round robin until 2006 where I had a great little team," explained Enns. "We didn't do as well as we would have liked in the round-robin only going 3-3 but we ended up squeaking into the playoffs." This is only the beginning of the story for Randy and his magical 2006 World Series. It didn't end with a ring but it certainly hooked Randy's participation into the MSBL World Series for life. The cherry on top is that this year Randy has been inducted into the 2016 edition of the MSBL World Series Hall of Fame. Here is the rest of his remarkable run in 2006.

"We had to win the Thursday late doubleheader to even have a chance and we had to keep the 'runs against' below eight in the two games and of course win both. We remarkably did that and then Friday morning we faced a 6-0 team in the playoffs and we beat them," said Randy. "Then we faced another 6-0 team and we also beat them. Then finally in our fifth game in 27 hours we had to beat a 5-1 team to go to the final and we did that also! That was probably the best day in baseball I have ever had. However, we left it all on the field in those five games and we could not maintain the following day and lost 12-2 in the final." A few years later in 2009 Randy started his current 45-over MSBL World Series team the CanAm A's, comprised of Canadian and American players that Randy has met over the years. This team has made the semifinals three times and unfortunately lost each time. Randy said he has added in some power and youth as they aren't getting any younger and needed to make some moves. "I have been playing here for 16 years and am still trying to find that right formula," said Enns. "Maybe this year will be our year. I hope so but if not, I always enjoy playing great ball with some great friends put on by a great organization. Thanks for the honor and the memories and thanks for thinking of this Canadian boy."

45+ And 60+ Teams Reach The Halfway Point In The Pool Play Round 25+ Teams Start Today As The Final Division Begins Play By Tom Prendergast

Teams that took the field on Tuesday enjoyed some of the best weather conditions of the tournament. With the temperature in the mid 80's, a cloudless sky and very little breeze, just ideal playing conditions. After two days, several very competitive divisions have developed. In some cases 3 and 4 teams are tied with the same record. If that trend continues a teams runs allowed becomes the most important stat after points. Because if 3 or more teams end up with the same record, after head to head competition (and they have to have all played each other), the next tie breaker is runs allowed. The same holds true for all wildcard teams, since multiple divisions and teams will be included.

Game scores are posted on the website as soon as they are reported to the WS office. In the event of a discrepancy, the home team book is the official record of the game. So if you think your teams score is incorrect, call the office and let a staffer know you think there's an issue with your teams stats. Also keep in mind that the Pointstreak server that we use for our team standings doesn't always list the teams in the proper order. For example if two teams have the same record, and team A is listed above team B (but team B beat team A) those standing will be reflected correctly in the Daily News. The playoff pairings will be based on those alone.


"I haven't lost a game pitching here at the World Series in about five years." Wow.


