Back To The Future? MSBL Memories From Past Years

In 1988, the world was different than it is today. No internet, cell phones or 24hr cable news. It seemed like a much simpler time.



More importantly for amateur adult baseball players, a national organization had formed and was looking for men, thirty years of age and over to play baseball.

Started in Long Island in 1987, founder Steve Sigler appeared on the Today Show and talked about his new, thirty and over baseball league. And after an article appeared in Sports Illustrated about the new league his phone didn't stop ringing. Almost overnight 30 and over baseball leagues began forming all across the country.

With so many new leagues and interest in adult baseball surging, Steve came up with the idea of an MSBL 30+/40+ World Series tournament in Phoenix, Arizona - played on MLB spring training fields. That first year 38 teams participated in inaugural event, sponsored in part by Smith-Barney.

Score reporting in the early days consisted mostly of calling scores into the office and then posting the scores on sheets of paper on the office wall. Every morning recap sheets with line scores from the previous days games were delivered to the players hotels. The early fields consisted of the 3 fields at the Tempe Diablo, 4 fields at Fitch, 2 fields in Chandler, Phoenix Municipal stadium and Compadre stadium.

Tournament director, Kurt Knop remembers the atmosphere that first year as "electric"! "Players were pumped up and thrilled to be playing on major league fields", he recalled. "Our first manager meeting was held up the hill at the Buttes and it was standing room only, as every team had at least three players on hand". "Steve spent two hours answering questions". Kurt said the best decision they made the first year was one they didn't use. "We originally had planned on using luxury buses to take the teams to and from the hotels to the fields, but as it turned out that didn't pan out, thankfully"! On Saturday night after the championship games they had a banquet at the Buttes and everybody had a wonderful time. "We knew after that this was going to be an annual event"! (continued on page 2)

Typically our players week in Arizona is filled with nostalgia, renewing old friendships, and of course, playing baseball. The fields we are using this year are truly outstanding. Starting with the fields at our headquarters, the 18 Tempe Diablo Complex. In addition to that we are using the Salt River 13 fields, Maryvale fields, the Peoria complex, the Goodyear complex, Fitch and Hohokam fields and my favorite, the Papago complex. The WS office is 4

open from 8:00am to midnight every day at Tempe Diablo Stadium.





SORRY BUT NO PETS

are allowed inside the Tempe Diablo Maryvale, Riverview, or Goodvear **Sports** Complexes as well as Tempe Diablo Stadium or Maryvale Stadium, per a city ordinance and regulation. No alcoholic beverages in the parking lot.



Special Playing Rules for 70+ WB Divisions

In an attempt to keep the 70+ WS divisions competitive and consistent, MSBL National has instituted the following rules for all 2017 World Series games:

- 1) No stealing
- 2) Three (3) courtesy runners (see rule 9)
- 3) One 9 inning game per day
- 4) 5 games in 5 days

- For any hit that reaches the outfield grass, the batter / runner cannot be thrown out at first.
- If a pitcher fails to go into the stretch position (with runners on base) and pitches with a full wind up, the base runner is allowed to steal or advance to the next base.
- With a 3-2 count on the batter and 2 outs, all forced runners can break on the delivery by the pitcher.
- If a wild pitch / passed ball goes out of the designated home plate circle, runners can advance (including to home plate) one base only without the catcher chasing the ball.
- We will use shared A/B batter positions. The manager uses two players for one batting position and during the game he decides who bats each time the batting position comes up. He can use the other player to run if he chooses to do so. There is no limit to the number of shared line-up positions. Any player sharing a batting order position is locked in that position for the duration of the game and cannot be used in any other batting order position.

All of the remaining rules are MSBL and MLB as stated in the WS tournament rules.

TEMPE DIABLO STADIUM COMPLEX ETIQUETTE/COMPLEX GUIDELINES

All Stretching, long and short toss will be conducted in the outfield at all times.

Soft toss and tee work will be conducted on the warning track. Do not hit into the Fence off the warning track – use portable netting.

PLAYERS - When taking practice swings or timing pitchers you must take your practice swings on the dirt area and NOT on the Grass. This helps avoid tearing up the Infield Grass.

Playing catch will only be allowed in the outfield. NO playing catch on the infield.

Do not throw baseballs against any buildings or fencing.

Batting cages between fields are NOT available for your player use. Coaches, when taking infield please make sure you are wearing turf shoes when hitting fungos. This helps avoid tearing up the infield grass.
