MSBL WS Iron Man - 30 year Attendee - Bob Korvas

Finding the MSBL WS placed opportunities, experiences and memories I would never have had if not said 'yes' to Mike Pinto. At the time I was only playing 16in 'Chicago style' (no glove) slow pitch softball. While not



exactly baseball, the game I grew up on as a kid and had a deep passion for satisfied my need to play and compete.

I saw an ad for a four day Randy Hundley Cubs baseball fantasy camp that included playing a day in Wrigley Field against several of my boyhood baseball hero's. My wife Kathy said I should do it as a 'birthday gift' so I did. This was where Mike invited me to participate in MSBL and where my new 'career' began.

Mike told me there was this new tournament coming in October in Arizona for players over 30 with teams from 'all over.' He was looking for players to enter a team and asked if I would be interested. I told Mike "let me think about it.' I thought '...could I compete or just make fool of myself?

We (Mike Pinto and ex-Cub Jose Cardenal) sat together at the Fantasy camp 'awards' banquet in Harry Carry's Restaurant downtown and became fast friends and teammates. From that time on our friendship grew to the point that I traveled as Jose's guest, meeting and traveled with the World Series Championship Yankees ('96 - '98), taught his wife how to drive and became god father to his son.

In my first ever MSBL World Series game we were at Grand Canyon College. Our Chicago North Cubs were playing against the Hollywood Stars. We only had 13 guys, with five guys that pitched, to cover six games over four days. In the first inning Jose hit a solo home run and I followed with a single. In the third inning personal history was made. Jose came up with a man on and hit his second homer over the left center field wall. I followed two pitches later with a drive over the 410 marker (continued on page 2)

At this time of the week, teams on the bubble (hoping to advance to the playoffs) really need to look no further than their runs allowed. Teams that give up fewer runs have the upper hand when it comes to advancing to the playoffs. Especially when we have wildcard berths involved. Here's what was listed on each playoff sheet: "Throughout the playoffs, the team with the best preliminary-round record will be afforded the automatic right as the home team. If two or more teams end in a tie and all the teams played each other, the tiebreaker would be head to head competition. If no head to head play was involved or head to head cannot decide the tiebreaker, then least runs allowed will be used. In order for a tie breaker to be decided by head to head with two or more teams, all teams would have needed to play each other and there be a definitive tiebreaker (ie: 1 team beats the other 2). If all teams played each other and A beat B, B beat C and C beat A, then least runs allowed will be used to determine the teams that advance."

And keep in mind that the standings on the MSBL National website do not reflect tiebreakers so the official standings will be the ones listed in this publication. For further clarification on the standings or seeding's, please call the World Series office (480) 858-7515.

in dead center field. I had gone back to back with a major leaguer.

Unfortunately we burned three pitchers in losing game one and finished 0-5-1. Our team was so bad that when we arrived to pick up Jose Cardenal for the game he waited in the lobby of the Buttes wearing his uniform and a paper bag with eye, nose and mouth holes cut out so as not to be recognized by his fellow major leaguers on the other teams. We had a good laugh. Never the less, I was hooked.

I have played alongside and against some pretty special ball players. <u>Team mates:</u> Jose Cardenal, Jerry Hairston, Rich Nye, Ken Rudolph, Bill Campbell and Pete LaCock. <u>Opponents:</u> Woody Williams, Ron Dunn, Jim Barr, Mel Hall, Rico Carty, Orlando Cepeda and Burt Campenaris.

I first read about Steve Sigler and MSBL in Sports Illustrated and we eventually met and became friends. Steve invited me to play (be his catcher) on the first MSBL team USA friendship series in St Thomas VI ('91,'92). I had the pleasure of meeting his entire, wonderful family. I pitched a complete nine inning game which we won and I also hit three home runs at the downtown soccer /baseball stadium, which included a 420 foot center field fence with a huge mahogany tree 'inside' on the field of all things. It was broadcast on 'national St. Thomas VI radio' and I was interviewed postgame as the player of the game, which was a thrill.

Championships are just one part of being there each year. Over 30 years at the MSBLWS I've been in the playoffs about 80% of the years, a Championship game over half, and won five rings.

I've caught a seven inning no hitter at Autry field for teammate (continued on page 3)
