Ron Lovell is a So Cal guy. He is a 60 year old pitcher and first baseman for the So Cal Fire in the 55+ and 60+ divisions and also plays with the So Cal Angels in the Father/Son division. Ron comes down to Arizona to play as much ball as he can and his So Cal teams have a long pedigree of success and have had for the 30 years he has been attending. His affiliated league during the year is, you guessed it, the So Cal MSBL. "In 1988 I first came down with the So Cal Yankees. We were able to win our first championship in 1994, a year I'll never forget." Why is that year one that sticks out? "The 1994 tournament included ten games with seven stadium games. There was a huge argument over who was supposed to be playing who in a playoff game, resulting in the semi-final being moved from Friday night to Saturday morning with beefed up security. It also resulted in a nail biting championship game that came down to the last out but we were able to pull it out 4-3. It was pretty crazy but also very special and remains my biggest thrill."



Ron has seen a lot of duty on the hill in Arizona while pitching but arm problems have pretty much sidelined him. "I hurt my elbow a few years back and the doctors told me to rest it and take it easy," added Lovell. "I did as they said but the next year I hurt it again and needed Tommy John surgery and just couldn't recover from it, but I love staying in the game by managing and occasionally playing first base."

Ron is one of the few people who have thrown their hat into the MSBL ring from day one and he is very grateful for the opportunity to keep playing a kid's game "I want to thank Steve Sigler for putting MSBL together and also thank all of my past and future teammates," said Ron. "It's been a Godsend for me. There's no place I'd rather be than on the ball field."

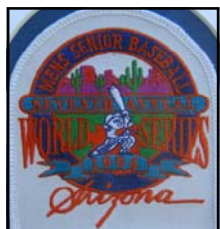

In 1993, 195 teams and approximately 3800 players participated in the MSBL World Series. Based on the success of the "old timers" exhibition game at the 1992 WS, we added a 50+ National division. We also added a new participation division, which required every team to get 15 players an at bat. Former LA Dodgers manager, Tommy LaSorda was the featured speaker at the MSBL WS banquet.

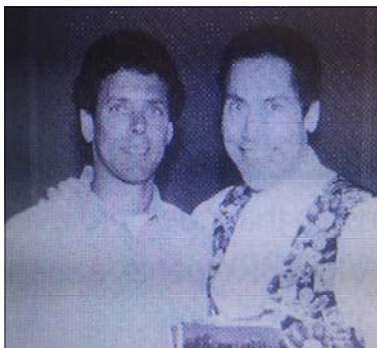
