## MSBL WS Iron Man - 30 year Attendee - Jay Ciambrone

Jay Ciambrone is a 66 year old, 2009 inductee into the MSBL World Series Hall of Fame. Like his friend, colleague and 30 year World Series participant Ron Lovell, Jay also resides in the So Cal MSBL and will be playing and heading up the So Cal Fire in the 60's, 65's and Father/Son divisions. His World Series career started on the same team as Ron. "We were the 30+ So Cal Yankees in 1988 and had a ball," said Ciambrone. "I played on the Yankees in the league, too, up until last year and switched to the Indians. They say once you play in Arizona you always come back. I guess as I reflect 30 years later, they were right!" Jay continues to play first base and second base with an occasional stint as DH. His team philosophy is the glue that keeps things together, keeps it fun and keeps it obviously successful. "We don't recruit ex-pros and college guys. Everyone should be given an opportunity to play," said Ciambrone. "You don't have to be the biggest or the best. We will always provide a place for you to play and help set you up with a tournament team to guarantee that you have the opportunity of playing in your own age division."

"We have long-standing team members like Ron Lovell, Randy Aosecki, Herb McKee and Duke Cullman who have been with us forever and just play for the love of the game," Ciambrone said. "That's why we're all out there. We don't reload every year to make a title run. We recruit good guys who fit in and share our team vision."

What moment remains the most special?

"2005 when we won in extra innings after changing fields to get lights at Papago. It was the first win for a team that I helped put together. That's hard to beat."

What is also the strangest thing you have witnessed at the World Series in your 30 years? "Wow, I could write a book,"

Ciambrone admitted. "One that sticks out is winning a title 2-1 where the last out was on a bad slide into second by the other team."

## Dehydration Issues Return With Temperatures In The Mid 90's Consuming Plenty of Water and Electrolytes Is A Must During The Day!

After two games yesterday, several players and some umpires were worn out and exhausted. Cramping and soreness was the norm for a lot of these players who just aren't used to these temperatures. So to be sure keep plenty of liquids on hand and consume as needed. Players who are not used to this kind of heat are susceptible to severe cramping.

As the pool play games to an end, runs allowed is always a key category for teams looking to advance to the playoff round. Especially for wildcard teams! And I should mention as we get close to the playoffs, teams that win are not allowed to protest a game because the other team didn't bat the proper number of batters. Only teams that lose games in a participation division can appeal the outcome through a protest.

Also, for teams using the Shared Batter position, this rule replaces the A/B batter and the courtesy runner. When a player is used as a base runner in the Shared Position, he must bat the next time his position in the order comes to the plate. After that point, either of the Shared Runners may bat in this position. This is not protectable - it's just like batting out of turn.

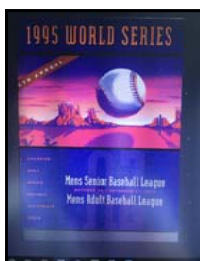

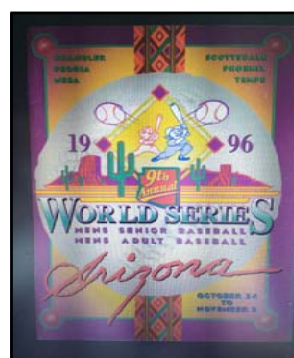
