
Charlie LaDuca (Father & Son Player)

Sixty-five year old Charlie LaDuca is a man of many 'bats.' He is the founder/owner of the Pro Bats wood bat manufacturing company based in Fredonia, New York and also manages the Pro Bats Yankees, a father/son Federal division entry in this year's MSBL World Series. Charlie also pitched for the LA Athletics in the 65+ American division early in week two and won his first ring ever. We caught up with Charlie as he was getting ready for his father/son team's playoff game on Saturday. "That was my first ring in 23 years of trying," said Charlie of his championship with the Athletics. "I love to pitch so I'm sure glad they asked me to come aboard now that I'm of age!" Charlie's Pro Bats has a long standing relationship with MSBL. "Years ago we sponsored one of the Las Vegas MSBL tournaments and recently advertised our product on the website and its other outlets so it's been wonderful and very positive". Championship game note: during the playoffs and championship games, all participation requirements are waived and teams only have to bat a minimum of 10 batters, per regular MSBL offense rules. In regards to the Father / Son rule that prohibits 3 sons batting in a row, the penalty for this is just like a batting out of turn infraction. The intent of the rule is to help keep the games competitive. This is not a protestable offense.

Charlie LaDuca (continued from page 1) who resides near Buffalo. "This is our fifth year coming down as the Pro Bats Yankees," said Charlie. "We've always made it to the playoffs and last year lost in the semi-final game and hope this year to go a little further. This year we are 2-2 (going into Saturday's playoff game) but had to play two of the teams from the upper division, but we like our chances in our own group."

Charlie further explained the team's preparation for the World Series.

"Coming from New York it's hard to get the reps in that are necessary so it took us a couple of games to get our legs under us but we're hitting the ball really well right now. I hope it continues.' Charlie's mound pedigree is far reaching. He has been pitching for all 23 of those years he's been coming down, having played for teams from New York, Boston or any other teams looking for a seasoned lefty. "The Athletics gave me the ball in the first game last week, which was an honor. I was able to throw eight innings and only gave up one earned run, which made me feel good. Our father/ son team has a lot of good 'father' arms so I've only thrown two innings but we'll see how it goes."






