MSBL WS Iron Man - 30 year Attendee - Ken Jaffee

You can do the math. Ken Jaffe is a 66 year old high school math teacher and baseball coach in the Watts and Compton area of California. He's there because he cares about the kid's welfare and of course baseball. He also cares about his own baseball career, as he is one of only a dozen MSBL players who have attended every MSBL World Series since its inception in 1988.



"I don't teach in the garden spot of California and the kids can't afford to attend baseball academies or play on traveling teams but they still love the game," said Jaffe. "I'm glad I can help them along a little bit and give them somewhere to play." Ken is a member of the Hollywood Stars and has been since 1988. They will be playing once again this year in the 60+ Cactus division and are there solely for the love of the game. "We are a family and don't try all winter to assemble a team of strangers in pursuit of the ring. We love each other, spend time together on and off the field and if we can go 3-3 during the week while getting to see each other once again, then all is well."

Ken and fellow thirty year man Rob Owens are the thirty year guys on the Stars but many of them have been making the journey almost as long. "We have a couple of 29 year guys and another that is a 27 year player. We had one other man who was on course to be here with Rob and I but he passed away after 27 consecutive years. We miss him but we keep plugging along. We are truly here for the love of the game and the relationships we've formed over the years." Ken only subs for the Stars during the summer, as they compete in the Los Angeles MSBL. "My focus is on playing in the World Series. I get my workout with the kids I coach. They think it's pretty cool that I'm still playing competitive baseball at my age. I think it's pretty cool, too."

Though the Stars play because of the experience and fellowship, that doesn't mean they can't be in the thick of things. "We have been to

With several very close divisions, today's games are for all practical purposes just like playoff games. In some instances however winning might not be enough, especially if your team is on the cusp of a wildcard berth. In that case there's a couple things to keep in mind; first fewest runs allowed is a key when multiple teams (in two or more divisions) have the same record. Checking the website for your runs allowed total is very important. However, the standings on the website are not official for a couple reasons. First the sort doesn't always reflect the actual standing, either head to head or fewest runs and for teams that received a participation point, those will only be recorded in the Daily News standings. Once your team qualifies for a playoff game, your manager will be notified and the game posted on the website. Due to the fact there are several late games tonight, playoff game notification could be very late. As soon as all of the scores are reported - the playoff pairings will be posted.
