Shared Batter vs Courtesy Runner Rule Confusion Is Unnecessary

Ex Professional Players Must Be Identified and Listed On Your MSBL WS Roster By Tom Prendergast

Every day at the MSBL / MABL WS office we get several phone calls concerning rule clarifications. Lately one of the most asked questions is about Shared Runner vs Courtesy Runner rule. Our official scorebook lists both as options. The managers packet that was sent out states that the Shared Runner rule will be used in divisions 55+ and over. So to resolve this issue (hopefully once and for all) both can be used. It's the team manager's choice, but it's still necessary to inform the other teams manager and I would let the umpires know as well. Good communication is always appreciated between teams and umpires.

The vast majority of players here this week did not play professional baseball, although many would have loved too. And who's not a bit envious of the guys that got paid to play! Any team that's fortunate enough to snag a former pro player has an advantage over the ones that don't. Our rules state that these players must be listed on *(continued on page 2)*

Joe Sidor - 2018 MSBL Hall of Fame

Steve LaMontia, Director of Coimmunications Joe Sidor is the 69 year old CEO of the Ohio MSBL, located in and around Canton, Ohio, who is an architect off the field and also an architect in the trenches while helping administer the league. He and his wife Dana live in Kent, Ohio, while Joe stays sharp on the field by playing in the league for the 55+ Sidewinders and the 65+ Ohio Phillies.

To keep his dance card punched he is also a long-standing MSBL WS player. Because of Joe's stunning accomplishments in the league and at the World Series, MSBL Founder and President Steve Sigler has inducted Joe into the 2018 class of the MSBL National Hall of Fame.

"I started going to the World Series in 2009 and have been going most years ever since," explained Sidor. "The highlight was in 2012 when we won the 65+ championship.

I have played in the 55+, 60+ and 65+ divisions mostly with the **Ohio Classics**. I have also played on some pool teams and had a great time, and this year we are starting our own 65+ team, the **OHIOMSBL Legends**."

But Joe's success isn't limited to his World Series accomplishments in October. It is merely a chapter of Joe's ball playing and league administrating resume. Here's what league member **Steve Masten** had to say about Joe's league involvement: (continued on page 3)

the roster submitted to the national office. In fact, under our Ex-Pro Guidelines allowance box is the following paragraph.

"The fact that a player has played professional baseball at any level for any length of time must be disclosed on the roster submitted to the MSBL tournament organizers. Failure to disclose a player's ex-professional status may result in disqualification of the player and forfeiture of any games in which the player participated."

I think it's a safe bet to assume that if a player on the other team performs at a high level, it's a given that somebody on the opposing team is going to do a quick Google search on their smart phone to see if they can locate any information on this guy. The message here is this, if a player on your team tells you he's got a friend that can pitch, ask the question; "is he a former pro player?" Because if you don't he might just end up being a former number one draft pick!

Joe Sidor - 2018 MSBL Hall of Fame (continued from page 2) I am so happy that Joe Sidor is being inducted into the national MSBL Hall of Fame as player, manager and league administrator. Please consider that he is CEO of the 27 team, five division Ohio MSBL and receives no compensation while managing one or more teams each season." Masten continued, "I looked back a couple years for some of his batting averages: 2018 – 65's .447, 2017 – 65's .455, 2016 – 55's .382, 2015 – 55's .375 and 60's .439. He has done as well over the years at the MSBL World Series and this year he is taking an OHIOMSBL Legends team to the series. Joe is well deserving of the recognition."

"We started the **OHIOMSBL** in 2009 with the help and support of **Steve Sigler**. Our original goal was to form a group of 4-5 teams that wanted to play on a better organized league than we had available to us in this area," said **Sidor**. "We were surprised and overwhelmed with the support we received from other players in the area, and have since grown to 27 teams as of now, with regular summer and fall schedules. Obviously running a league of this size takes more than myself and I couldn't do it without the help and support of (2018 HOF Inductee) **Skip Riser**, **Steve Masten**, **Nick Loukas** and all the managers that week in and week out put in the organization that makes our league successful." But I am especially honored to be receiving this award in the same year that my league partner and co-founder, **Skip Riser**, is receiving this award. No one is more deserving of this award than he...both because of his rich and successful career in playing the game, but his selfless dedication in providing leadership for us!
